

4H BOYS AND GIRLS TO MEET AT PURDUE U.

Every Part of Indiana to Be Represented Beginning Tuesday.

LAFAYETTE, Ind., April 27.—Boys and girls from every part of Indiana, members of 4H agricultural or home economics clubs, will gather at Purdue University Tuesday in the tenth annual boys' and girls' club round-up, to continue through Friday.

The program has been arranged and detailed plans made at the university for handling the largest gathering of club members ever assembled in the State. The group will consist principally of winners in townships and counties who have earned trips to Purdue because of outstanding work in the clubs in which they have been enrolled. Industrial vocational boys will meet at the university the same week.

Judging First
The round-up will begin Tuesday with judging contests for both boys and girls. Corn, poultry and egg, beef cattle, swine and sheep judging will be held for boys' teams, with horse and dairy cattle judging next.

Baking, canning and clothing judging contests for the girls will be held Wednesday and health contests for both groups are scheduled for the same day.

The entire period from Tuesday to Friday night will be filled with features, addresses, demonstrations, contests and recreational events.

Ten-Year Age Range
These in club work are from 10 to 20 years of age and those in attendance will be all ages within this range.
President E. C. Elliott will welcome the youthful visitors to the campus in an address Wednesday, and Miss Helen Faye Kinney, club member from Spencer, will respond. R. A. Turner of the United States Department of Agriculture, Roy P. Visehart, State superintendent of public instruction, and Director G. I. Christie of the Purdue experiment station will be principal speakers. The university will observe its annual open house Friday night and the visitors, with townspeople, will get to see the university in full swing.
