WATSON'S RACE TAKES DEFENSE

Scant 400 Turn Out for
Elkhart Address.

ELKHART, Ind., April 27.—Before
the smallest audience he ever ad-
dressed in this city, Senator James
E. Watson Thursday night made a
lengthy defense of his candidacy for
Indiana's presidential preference
vote and explained "it would be ut-
terly futile for me to make speeches
in other States seeking delegates un-
til it is actually demonstrated that
I can carry my own State."

Watson made no reference to the
source of statements that his candi-
dacy is insincere and hopeless, but
probably was aware of the editorial
which appeared Thursday in the
Elkhart Truth, pro-Hoover paper,
which said:

"Hoover is running against a dead
man as far as the attainment by
Senator Watson of the presidency
of the United States is concerned."

Watson's comment on the sweep-
ing Hoover victory in Ohio had
been: "Hoover is not running
against a dead man in Indiana."

With less than 400 persons in the
hall, Senator Watson commented on
the smallness of the audience, but
said he had "never received such a
warm reception."

Watson will go to Indianapolis to-
night to confer with his Marion
County supporters and to address
a mass meeting at the Armory Sat-
urday night.
