

DALE BELABORS SHUMAKER FOR 'WET' EPITHET

Saloon League Head Beset by Many Annoyances Has Nothing to Say.

The Rev. E. S. Shumaker, Indiana Anti-Saloon League superintendent, very busy at his office in the Roosevelt Bldg., refused admittance to newspaper men while the mail man walked right in with fresh annoyances.

A letter from George Dale, Muncie publisher and candidate for the Democratic nomination for Governor, reached Shumaker, purporting to "call his bluff," while the superintendent pondered the outcome of a charge of violating the corrupt practices act, brought by Attorney General Arthur L. Gilliom, Republican senatorial candidate, and resulting in his arrest at South Bend Tuesday.

Dale, like Gilliom, was designated wet in the American Issue, Anti-Saloon League mouthpiece.

"I have as much right to send you a questionnaire as you have to send me one," Dale's letter read. "If I should send you a questionnaire with but a single question, 'Are you or are you not a horse thief,' and you would refuse to answer, I would have just as much right to call you a horse thief and publish it in the newspapers, as you have to broadcast your statement that I am wet, because I refused to tell you whether I was or not."

Unable to see Shumaker, reporters got no comment from him on the questionnaire which Thomas H. Adams, Republican candidate for Governor, addressed to him Tuesday, in which he asked how Shumaker could endorse Senator Arthur R. Robinson's candidacy in the face of bootleg defense undertaken by his law firm, and Congressman Ralph E. Updike, considering his contract with D. C. Stephenson for the distribution of patronage upon Stephenson's recommendation.

"I have neither the time nor the inclination to answer Mr. Adams," was Shumaker's reply to a reporter in South Bend Tuesday.

Shumaker posted bond of \$1,000 to insure his liberty awaiting trial.

ARREST 76 ON U. S.

RUM CHARGES IN APRIL

Large Amount of Liquor Confiscated in Last Month.

Arrest of seventy-six liquor law violators and confiscation of 1,676 gallons of liquor and 4,660 gallons of mash were announced by George L. Winkler, deputy dry administrator, in his April report.

While the number of arrests is not large, the amount of liquor confiscated is much larger than usual, Winkler said, indicating that many of those arrested were big dealers.

During the month, ninety-seven persons were convicted in Federal Court, twelve in State courts, twenty-nine abatement suits filed in Federal Court and fifteen permanent injunctions obtained, seven stills confiscated, 814 gallons of alcohol, 580 gallons of malt liquor and 232 gallons of wine.

URGES INDIANA CLEANUP

Ohio Editor Predicts Hoover Would Win Against Smith.

"We of Ohio hope and expect that you will have a housecleaning in Indiana, 'a la Illinois,'" said John C. Barnett of Urbana, Ohio, twenty-one years editor of Farm and Fireside, in a telegram to Hoover State headquarters here today. Barnett, who is now engaged extensively in agriculture, predicted "Hoover will carry Ohio triumphantly" in the fall if Smith is the Democratic nominee.

Kern is a brother of United States Commissioner John Kern, Jr., and a graduate of Princeton University and Harvard Law School. His father, the late John W. Kern, Sr., formerly was United States Senator.

PLAN REORGANIZATION OF CINCINNATI TRACTION

Will Build Two Corporations From Recently Purchased Company.

The public service commission within a few weeks will receive plans for the financial organization to be reared by Ohio capitalists who purchased the Indianapolis & Cincinnati Traction Co. at a receivers' sale in Knoxville Monday for \$500,000.

Purchasers who are represented by Charles T. Dehore of Cincinnati, and Leroy T. Eastman of Toledo, plan reorganization of the company into two corporations, one to handle transportation and the other light and power distribution.

The capitalists have purchased five neighborhood companies for \$175,000 to be added to the new corporation. Improvements will cost \$250,000.
