

## URGES UNIFORM TRAFFIC SIGNS

One System for Autoists Over Nation Advocated.

NEW YORK, Oct. 3.—Value of a uniform system of traffic signals and signs, urged by traffic experts, has been tested and proved this summer in Massachusetts, Charles C. Jones, secretary of the Ohio State Automobile Association, told the safety congress in session here, this morning.

Since June 5, Massachusetts has had a single system of traffic marks and directions, so that a motorist can travel through the en-

tire State without confusion by local variations.

"What a pleasure it must be for the Massachusetts resident to motor through his State!" said Mr. Jones, commending the excellent example of the State in undertaking the task of bringing every city and village under the uniform system of directions.

Jones urged not only uniform traffic signs throughout the United States, but the adoption of the entire uniform traffic law.

"When motorists and pedestrians are thoroughly familiar with the law by which they are to abide, they will be in better position to take care of themselves," he stated. "As is now, a few minutes' drive takes a motorist from one jurisdiction where he understands the regulations to another where lack of knowledge makes him an innocent menace."
