

NEW YORK HAS EXPENSIVE NEW MEDICAL HOME

Various Hospitals Brought Together in \$21,000,000 Building.

NEW YORK, Oct. 12.—A ceremony dedicating New York's \$21,000,000 Medical Center to the three-fold purpose of teaching, research and care of the sick took place today in the presence of scores of educators, humanitarians and men of medicine.

The Medical Center, representing a development of the ideal of joint administration of various health activities, is composed of twelve units—the College of Physicians and Surgeons, the School of Dental and Oral Surgery and the Dr. Lamar Institute of Public Health—all or Columbia University—the New York State Psychiatric Institute and Hospital, the Presbyterian Hospital of New York, the Presbyterian Hospital School of Nursing, the Squier

Urological Institute, the Harkness Private Pavilion, the Neurological Institute of New York, the Babies' Hospital of New York, the Sloane Hospital for Women and the Vanderbilt Clinic.

Six months were consumed in moving the various hospitals to the Medical Center and during the last month the university has moved its teaching groups.

Today's ceremony also will see the professions of dentistry and medicine brought together for the first time in New York City in a combined building, with the dental and medical students having many of their courses in common. This is the first move toward the realization of the ideals of leaders in the dental profession who desire to see dentistry become a definite part of the medical profession and the dentist recognized as a medical specialist on a par with the surgeon.

The address of dedication will be given by Dr. Samuel W. Lambert, dean emeritus of the College of Physicians and Surgeons and president of the New York Academy of Medicine.

ANNEX AT TECH IS NEAR FINISH

New Wings Will Relieve Congested Conditions.

Additions to the main building at Technical High School are near completion. Workmen are rushing

the job and the wings will be ready by the end of the month.

Heretofore many classes have been held in halls and basements, due to congested conditions. Work was begun in May of this year.

The present main building, a beautiful structure of three stories containing 100 rooms, was completed in the fall of 1922. In it are the newest and most modern conveniences and equipment found in any school.

The wings, which are on the east side, are built out from special coves, left for such a purpose by the designer and architect. Each wing

contains seventeen rooms, provided with offices, closets and necessary laboratory fixtures.

First and second floors of the south wing are constructed as laboratories for the science department. The third floor may be used for lecture and recitation rooms. In the north wing the first floor is equipped with gas stoves, built-in cabinets, refrigerators, and all modern conveniences found in the latest homes for the home economics department.

BLIND; BARBER CURES

Sight Is Restored by Use of Electric Vibrator.

PASSAIC, N. J., Oct. 12.—Blindness overtook Leo G. de Bremont last May. Efforts of medical authorities failed to bring back his sight.

Recently de Bremont entered a

local barber shop for a shampoo and massage. The barber was using an electric vibrator when his customer suddenly sprang from the chair crying, "I can see! I can see!"

It is now believed that a blood clot, broken by the vibrator, was the cause of de Bremont's blindness.
