

# WALKER MAY PROBE SLAYING OF 'BET KING'

Cops Told to Turn Up Something by Monday or—Take Consequences.

NEW YORK, Nov. 16.—Police jumped higher and higher today in an attempt to solve who killed Arnold Rothstein, a question that looms much greater than the old Cock Robin story, because they have just until Monday to learn that point.

Thus far most of the investigation of Rothstein's death, has been done in the city hall with Mayor Walker doing the investigating and the police nervously answering the questions.

The mayor's questions invariably have been: "What has been accomplished?" and when that brought nothing definite, the next question was "why?"

Thursday, Walker informed the commissioner of police, a detective inspector, and a group of detectives that something had to be produced by Monday or personally he would take command.

It was the first time in many, many years that a New York mayor has abandoned the duties of unrolling statues and greeting city visitors in order to take charge of the metropolitan police department.

**Wields Strange Influence**  
It is a strange influence that this fellow Arnold Rothstein wields over the city, even in death. One can wander up Broadway, drop in at Lindy's, walk into one or two of the hotels where the gambling circuit operates—for New York's gamblers work a circuit whereby they don't play in the same hotel every night—or lounge about the district where the sporting element gather, and hear a hundred tales about Arnold.

Yet when you sum it all up you find you have learned that he was the unique character you always knew he was, but you don't know anything about him.

Thus far police have not been able to talk with Jimmy Meehan, at whose home Rothstein lost more than \$300,000, and for which he gave I O Us, "Honest George" McManus, who rented a room at the hotel in which Rothstein was shot, or "Tough Willie" McCabe, Chicago racketeer, to whom Rothstein was said to have owed thousands of dollars, because the police cards didn't fall his way recently, yet it seems none of the creditors have been in the need of money, for none have displayed any great activity toward collecting.

The government is trying to connect Rothstein with an international narcotic ring. One question to which the government seeks an answer is: Why did Sidney Stajer, arrested for being an international dope seller, inherit the income from \$75,000 for ten years under Rothstein's will?

The government claims that is evidence of something or another, although Stajer claimed he and Rothstein had been business partners for fifteen years. There is some hope that the .38 caliber pistol with which Rothstein was shot may be traced.

Also New York police were interested in the attempt to shoot Eddie Diamond in Denver. Diamond is said to have been an enemy of Rothstein and the gunmen held for the shooting in Denver both are from the east.

There might be a connection between that Denver shooting and Rothstein's death, many say.


