

Aviation — BEACON CHAIN TO GUIDE FLIER, CITY TO DAYTON

Government Starts Work
Here on Lights and
Landing Fields.

Lighting of the airway between Indianapolis and Dayton and establishment of emergency landing fields along the route is being arranged by Walter Avery of the department of commerce airways division.

Avery landed at Indianapolis airport Friday from Rochester, N. Y., in a Douglas O-2 biplane. He expects to be here about a month. He said the landing fields are to be established approximately every twenty-five miles for benefit of the Transcontinental Air Transport forty-eight-hour coast-to-coast air passenger line, which is to start April 7, and for the public.

These emergency fields are leased and equipped by the government. Beacon lights will be established every ten miles.

The lights and fields will be particularly valuable to the T. A. T. on its east-bound trip, as its passenger planes will reach Indianapolis from St. Louis late in the evening and may be forced to fly through the dark to Columbus, by way of Dayton, on winter nights.

The airway from Columbus to Dayton already is lighted and emergency landing fields established as part of the Cleveland-Columbus-Dayton-Louisville air mail route. Lighting of the Cincinnati-Indianapolis-Chicago air mail route already has been started by the department of commerce.

Avery conferred after his arrival here with Captain H. Weir Cook, general manager of Curtiss Flying Service of Indiana, distributors of the Curtiss Robin monoplane, has received a telegram informing him that the world's record for the greatest number of consecutive barrel rolls was made in a Robin cabin ship.

The record was established recently by Dale Jackson, who made 417 consecutive barrel rolls.

The barrel roll is a horizontal spin with full engine power, the wings of the plane revolving around the fuselage as an axis. It creates a heavy strain on a plane, especially on a cabin plane.

The Curtiss school here has received four Robins from the factory at St. Louis and Captain Charles E. Cox Jr. and Lieutenant Fred J. Maibucher, fliers of the Curtiss company, were to deliver two more of the cabin planes here today.

THREE INJURED SERIOUSLY IN AUTO CRASHES

Woman Hurlled to Street
When Sedan Hits Rear
of Fruit Truck.

Three persons were hurt seriously in a series of week-end traffic accidents culminating this morning in a crash of a fruit truck and a sedan at Park avenue and Thirty-third street.

Hurled to the sidewalk when a sedan struck the rear of the truck on which she was riding, Mrs. Sarah Downey, 60, of 2250 North Rural street, was injured internally. She was removed to city hospital.

Mike Mercurio, 20, of 909 South New Jersey street, was driving on Thirty-third street. In the driver's seat with him were Mrs. Downey and her daughter, Ruby, 19, going

to their fruit stand at Thirty-fourth street and Central avenue.

J. E. Sweeney, 40, of 3941 Ruckle street, was the driver of the Buick sedan which struck the rear of Mercurio's truck at the intersection. Mercurio and the girl, Sweeney and two companions in the sedan, were injured. Bananas were strewn over the street and sidewalks.

Mercurio was arrested by motor-police Ed Ball and Charles Felton, charged with assault and battery and reckless driving, Sweeney having the right of way.

Ferdinand Schaefer, 65, of 799 East drive, Woodruff Place, violin teacher, at the Boston Academy of Music, was injured seriously Sunday afternoon when he was struck at Thirty-third and Meridian streets by an automobile driven by Clyde H. Lively, 26, of 1369 North Gale street.

He was removed to St. Vincent's hospital. One shoulder was dislocated and concussion of the brain is feared. Lively was charged with assault and battery.

Gory Prather, 40, of Irvington, Ky., suffered severe internal injuries and possible fracture of the pelvis, when an automobile in which he and five others were en route to Kentucky collided with another car at Tibbs avenue and Sixteenth street late Saturday.
