

## WALES TO VISIT 'JAMBOREE' OF 50,000 SCOUTS

Boys From 67 Nations Are  
Attending World Meeting  
in England.

ARROWE PARK, England, Aug. 1.—Heavy rains which beat intermittently throughout the night on the tented city of the "world jamboree" of Boy Scouts, forcing cancellation of the opening night campfire ceremonies, failed today to dampen the ardor of the 50,000 lads from sixty-seven nations as they looked forward to welcoming the prince of Wales this evening at their "big bowl."

The prince will inspect the camp and will witness all of the colorful ceremonies of the evening. He will spend the night as a guest of the Scouts, sleeping in a tent.

Friday, Charles G. Dawes, United States ambassador, is to be the honor guest, but the press of diplomatic affairs will prevent his remaining over night.

The prince of Wales is to deliver an address at the international rally Friday.

The 1,300 American Scouts continued today to draw a major portion of the interest of the crowds from neighboring towns and cities. The Indian motif is carried out throughout the entire American section of the camp. William Tompkins of San Diego, Cal., gathered Nigerians, Bulgarians and Poles around his campfire before the rain descended Wednesday night and taught them the Indian sign language.

Scouts from Rockford, Ill., and Ft. Wayne, Ind., are building a fifty-foot Indian tent pole which they expect to leave in Arrowe Park as a permanent memorial of their visit.



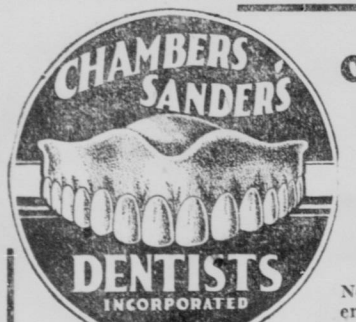

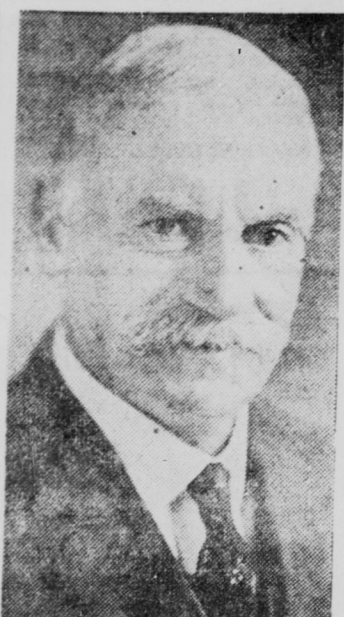

## CITY EDUCATORS RIDICULE PLAN OF WESTERNER

Indianapolis Not Likely to Adopt Suggestion of 'Fining Flunkers.'

Indianapolis is not likely to adopt the idea of a western school superintendent that students who flunk in public schools be taxed \$30 a semester for the courses they have to take over, a survey of educators indicates.

W. A. Kern, superintendent of Walla Walla (Wash.) schools, advocates the plan in an article in the magazine Time. He declares most failures are due to laziness and students should be penalized.

Indianapolis school board, emphatically opposed the idea. "Students who chronically fail are sufferers under our compulsory educational laws which require a student to stay in school until his sixteenth year no matter how incapable he may be of absorbing instruction," said Vonnegut. To tax such students \$30 for each repeated course would be a ridiculous injustice.

"It is the teacher who has flunked," commented Charles C. York, business director of schools. "Either the teaching or the curriculum is not adapted to the student. Those who fail are unfortunately placed. For them to be because of their misfortune would be adding insult to injury."

"To adopt Kern's plan would be to emphasize failure," said Miss Emma Colbert, dean of the Teachers College of Indianapolis. "The whole idea of modern education is to stress success. Certainly the parents of flunking students would be the sufferers."
