## NEW CHAIN OF DRUG STORES IS ORGANIZED

Goldsmith Company Will  
Open First Shop in  
Anderson Sept. 1.

Organization of a one-half million dollar chain of drug stores in Indiana and the central west was announced today by Julius Goldsmith, vice-president of the newly created Goldsmith Bros. Co. Inc.

General offices and warehouses of the company will be located in Indianapolis. Present offices are at 118-120 South Capitol avenue.

The company is capitalized at 10,000 shares no par value.

The first store will be opened in Anderson in the new Palmer theater building, Sept. 1.

"It will be the finest drug store in Indiana," according to Julius Goldsmith. One feature will be a forty-two-foot fountain.

The plans call for twenty-five stores in Indiana and surrounding states. Several stores will be opened by Jan. 1.

Goldsmith Brothers operated a chain of drug stores in Indianapolis until last December when they sold out to Walgreen company.

"Our plans are for the opening of beautiful and modern drug stores in each city that we select as an operating point," the vice-president said.

Other officers are So Goldsmith, president, and Louis Goldsmith, secretary and treasurer.
