

# JOHN F. RYAN ENDS OWN LIFE IN CALIFORNIA

Body of Former City Man  
Will Be Brought Here  
for Services.

The body of John F. Ryan, 45, son of Mr. and P. J. Ryan, 540 Central court, north, who died Wednesday in his Los Angeles home, probably will arrive in Indianapolis Saturday, relatives said today.

Mr. Ryan, according to United Press dispatches, committed suicide by swallowing poison after failure to effect a reconciliation with his estranged wife.

He was a veteran of the World war, having served as a lieutenant in the Twenty-eighth United States Infantry. Members of the American Legion will conduct a military funeral service, firing a salute over the grave in Holy Cross cemetery.

Surviving him, besides the parents, are three brothers, William, Joseph, and Francis Ryan of Indianapolis; the widow, Mrs. Mary Van Winkle Ryan, Los Angeles, and two sisters, Mrs. J. M. Fox, Denver, and Mrs. Byron C. Young, Hollywood, Fla.
