

## LOBBY PROBE BY SENATE TO GET UNDER WAY

Washington's Inside Story  
Scheduled to Start  
This Week.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 7.—The inside story of Washington, with chapters about how lobbyists work to influence government policies, how society affects congressional votes and how former congressmen and government officials are employed by interests here, promises to be started this week before a new senatorial investigating committee.

It will be the most extensive undertaking in the investigating line congress has inaugurated and, according to those who are sponsoring it, all propagandists, large and small, secret and open, good and bad, will be called upon to reveal their activities.

The sub-committee which is to conduct the inquiry was to be selected today at a meeting of the senate judiciary committee. Among those expected to serve are Senator Thomas J. Walsh, who uncovered the Teapot Dome oil scandal in a senatorial investigation; Senator Caraway (Dem. Ark.), author of the project, and perhaps Chairman Norris of the judiciary committee.

Plans for the inquiry have been outlined unofficially by expressions from most of those who are expected to serve. They want to begin hearings before the end of the week, delving first into the tariff lobbyists. During every tariff contest, various manufacturers' associations maintain attorneys or publicity representatives or both here to see their interests are either benefited or protected.

Joseph R. Grundy, president of the Pennsylvania Manufacturers' Association, who raised more than \$1,000,000 for the Republican presidential campaign of 1924, is present almost daily at the capitol and will be one of the first witnesses called. Caraway has said he also wants the Southern Tariff Association called. It is a protective tariff agency which has been operating widely in the south.

Prospective members of the committee say they intend also to go into the war and dry lobbies, the peace and war propagandists, the Muscle Shoals power and fertilizer groups, and others.

It has been customary for many senators and congressmen who have passed out of office to set up legal offices in Washington. There

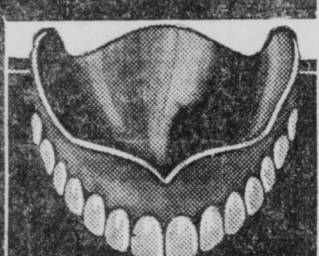
## 47-Pounder Is Freshman

## COFFIN WORKER GETS POSITION

Roy Bell Is Named Clerk in  
School Shops.

Roy Bell, former deputy sheriff and coffin political worker, today became clerk in the shops of the Indianapolis public school system, replacing Robert Castle, who was ousted Friday after six years service.

According to Phil Zoercher of the state tax board, Castle's discharge came because he revealed to Zoercher methods used by the school board in buying several thousands of dollars worth of C. C. Shipps ventilating supplies without bid or contract.

How this was done, without technical violation of the law, was disclosed by Zoercher at a school tax hearing recently.

Castle's father had been discharged from employment with the school city several weeks ago.

No such revelations are expected from a member of the Coffin political machine, it was pointed out. Bell secured the job through Omer Hawkins, Marion county Republican chairman and George V. (Boss) Coffin ally.
