

GRUNDY FEELS HIGHER TARIFF NATION'S WILL

Manufacturer Tells Lobby
Probers Republicans Have
Mandate.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 24.—In a crowded marble hearing room, Joseph R. Grundy, most influential of the legislative agents and promoter of political funds, was interrogated today as the leading witness in the Senate lobby investigating committee.

His white hair smoothly brushed, the Bristol (Pa.) worsted manufacturer, who has been active in tariff fights since the Dingley bill of 1897, bore the appearance of a veteran witness before congressional committees.

Grundy said he had been a manufacturer for fifty years and Chairman Caraway began the examination asking the witness first what he did in Washington.

Interested in Tariff

"Endeavoring to have a protective tariff law enacted," said Grundy, leaning on the witness table and following Caraway closely.

"Well there was a protective law before you were born," said Caraway. "What were you doing?"

"I was trying to see the protection was preserved."

"How often have you been investigated for lobbying?"

"Never."

"How many times have you been here for examination about raising political money?"

After several exchanges, Grundy said he had raised \$700,000 for the Coolidge campaign of 1924.

Admits Investigating Rates

Caraway accused Grundy of modifying in denying that he had written many tariff bills of the past. Grundy admitted, however, he had instigated some rates.

"Who pays your expenses?"

"I do."

"It's just a work of love on your part."

"No, I have certain obligations. I felt the Republican party ought to enact into law the tariff bill promised at Kansas City—a mandate given by 33,000,000 people in the last election. This government is run by parties. When one party proposes a policy and when that party receives a mandate from the people to carry out a certain principle in legislation, its duty is to do so."

Dr. F. E. Smith, secretary of the board of pensions, said \$8,000 will be raised for ministers' pensions next year. A banquet was held at the Irvington M. E. church Wednesday night.
