

BRITISH LOWER HOUSE FAVORS PEACE MOVES

Commons Backs Reduction of Arms; Pay Tribute to Hoover Speech.

LONDON, Dec. 5.—Great Britain's house of commons once more has voted confidence in Prime Minister J. Ramsay MacDonald's moves toward world peace and reduction of armaments.

The expression of confidence was the commons' voteless approval of a motion asking the government to do everything in its power to stimulate international action for reduc-

tion and limitations of naval, military and war armaments, adding that it is "desirable to co-ordinate the defense forces of this country."

Former Premier David Lloyd George, speaking for the motion, paid tribute to President Hoover's armistice day speech and his earnest efforts toward international understanding.

"He did not cry peace where there was no peace," Lloyd George said. "Everybody is proceeding on the assumption that after the last war war is impossible. Nobody had the courage to say that was not so except Hoover."

The liberal leader cited the increasing armaments since 1914 and referred to the eloquent speeches at Geneva favoring peace, disarmament and arbitration.

"The League of Nations is in danger of failure by being run by flounders," he added. "You are not going to get peace with 30,000,000 armed men and gigantic armaments. The chariot of peace can not advance along a road cluttered with cannon."

CHURCH SLATES PARLEYS IN 1930

Disciples of Christ Will Meet in Washington.

Two important gatherings of Disciples of Christ will be held in October, 1930, in Washington, D. C. It was decided here Wednesday by the program committee of the International convention of Christian churches.

The regular convention will be held Oct. 14 to 19 and the world convention of the 1900th anniversary of Pentecost will be observed Oct. 19 to 23.

At least 15,000 members of Christian churches from various parts of the world are expected to attend both meetings.


