

FIVE INJURED IN AUTO ACCIDENTS IN INDIANAPOLIS

Woman, Hurt Two Months
Ago, Dies of Injuries;
Two Arrested.

Five were injured in automobile accidents reported to police Thursday night, and a woman died of injuries suffered in a traffic mishap more than two months ago. Two motorists were arrested after crashes.

Arthur F. Light, 64, Mickleyle, stepped from behind a parked car at Market street and Capitol avenue into the path of a machine driven by John Crawford, 24, of 2114 Sugar Grove avenue, and was knocked to the pavement. City hospital physicians say his collar bone is fractured.

Deputy sheriffs arrested W. S. Smith, 59, of 1601 Holliday street, on charges of reckless driving, assault and battery and drunken driving after his truck collided with an auto driven by Elmer Smith, 1148 University avenue, at Tibbs avenue and Morris street Thursday night.

Cut on Face

Robert Smith, 8, and his mother, Mrs. Anna Smith, passengers in the auto, were injured slightly.

Ralph Banks, 1626 South Illinois street, was cut on the face when his car collided with a street car at Vermont and Fulton streets, and later was arrested on charges of drunkenness and drunken driving. Mrs. Nicholas Lux, 38, of 3631 North Capitol avenue, succumbed in St. Vincent's hospital to injuries sustained when her husband's auto collided with an Indianapolis Street Railway bus at Sixteenth and Meridian streets Sept. 29.

Hits Traffic Light

Struck by an auto driven by Lee Meyers, 24, of 835 South Cass street, at Washington and California streets today, Mrs. Ella Stalcup, 40, of 226 Bright street, was bruised slightly and taken to her home.

Alleged to have been crowded by a bus into the center of the street, Cecil Hodge, 2822 Brookside avenue, drove into a traffic light standard at Meridian and Michigan streets Thursday night, wrecking the auto and displacing the cement light standard.

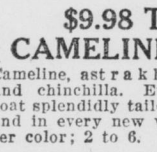

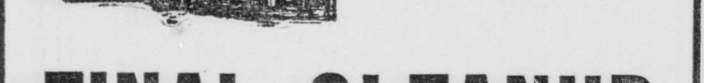
