

GLIDER CLUB IS FORMED AGAIN BY BUTLERITES

Coach Clark to Direct New Organization; Open Membership.

A new glider club is being organized at Butler university under the direction of Coach Patsy Clark, it was announced today. The club will use the glider presented to the university by L. Straus & Co., now housed in the Curtis Flying Service hangar at the Mars Hill airport. Membership in the club will be open to any man interested in this form of flying. It is planned to obtain services of an expert glider instructor to instruct all members in use of controls before they are permitted to make a flight. INJURY 28 YEARS AGO CAUSES MAN'S DEATH

Fall From Tree Brought Diseases to Resident Near Trenton.

TRENTON, Ind., Dec. 18.—Diseases which developed after an injury twenty-eight years ago caused the death near here of Fred De-batty, 49. He was suffering from asthma, heart disease and other ailments. When De-batty was 21 years old he fell fifty-two feet from a hickory tree while gathering nuts. For the next nine months he was in a critical condition and for two years was bedfast. Later he was able to walk with the aid of crutches and afterward these were discarded for a cane.

TRAIN WRECK AVERTED

San Francisco Held for Near Accident; Traced by Fingerprints.

LOS ANGELES, Dec. 18.—Leonard Fuschini, San Francisco, was under arrest today on charges of having attempted to wreck a tourist-filled westbound Continental limited of the Union Pacific railway. A track inspector flagged the train after having found two heavy pieces of steel laid across the track. Fuschini's fingerprints were said to correspond to those found on the improvised derail.

ANCIENT LEGAL THEORY SENDS MAN TO JAIL

Husband Accused Because of Wife's Acts in His Presence.

RUSHVILLE, Ind., Dec. 18.—Al Isley of Indianapolis is held in the Rush county jail here as a result of an ancient legal theory that a wife who commits certain crimes in the presence of her husband, does so under his direction, and that he, not she, is punishable. In Rush circuit court here Tuesday Isley's wife, Mrs. Mary Isley, was acquitted of attempting to free Vinson Mingle and Lee Karney, Indianapolis, from the county jail here. Although there was evidence that she had smuggled saws to the men, she was freed as the act was committed while her husband was in her company.

PLEADS FOR NEW SHIPS

Retired German Naval Leader Urges Building of Battle Cruisers.

BERLIN, Dec. 18.—Construction of three additional "vest-pocket battleships," modeled after the "Er-satz Preussen," which has aroused the admiration of naval experts throughout the world, is urged by Admiral Zenker, retired chief of staff of the German navy. Admiral Zenker demands that Germany increase her fleet to the maximum permitted under the Versailles treaty. It is assumed that the admiral is speaking for those now controlling the German naval policy.

REVIVE WEDDING RUMOR

King Boris' Acceptance to Attend Royal Nuptials Reopens Interest.

SOFIA, Bulgaria, Dec. 18.—An acceptance by King Boris of an invitation to attend the wedding of Crown Prince Humbert of Italy and Princess Marie Jose of Belgium at Rome has revived interest in rumors that the announcement of Boris' own engagement to Princess Giovanna of Italy might be expected within a short time.
