

BORAH READY TO CUT LOOSE ON DRY CHIEFS

Idaho Senator Bolsters
Mass of Explosive
Evidence.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 24.—An explosive mine of material, concerning prohibition enforcement laxities and alleged frauds, is being hidden away in the private files of Senator William E. Borah of Idaho, the constitutional dry leader, who charged the enforcement personnel was bad "from top to bottom."

Since he made the charge, during the Christmas holidays, Borah has received numerous sensation tales, charges, and affidavits from persons throughout the country, who claim to have personal information. Even before he made the charge, Borah obtained evidence concerning seventeen district attorneys throughout the country and now he has bolstered this information with more material than he has been able to digest.

While he has declined to comment upon any of it or to reveal any of his facts, it is expected Borah will use this information from the floor of the senate as soon as the tariff bill is completed, probably within two weeks. His intention will be to force removal of some of the present dry officials, his friends have indicated.

"Watkins is a member of the educational staff of the American City Bureau, and is educational director for the Indianapolis Forward movement."

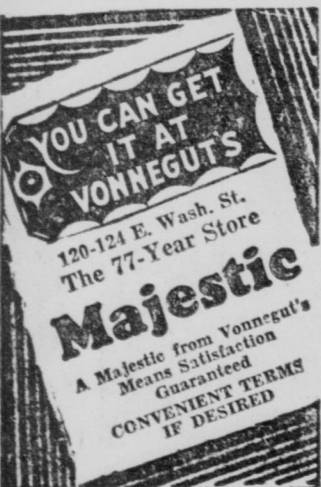
The meeting is one of a series scheduled throughout the month of February for the southern Illinois and Indiana conferences.

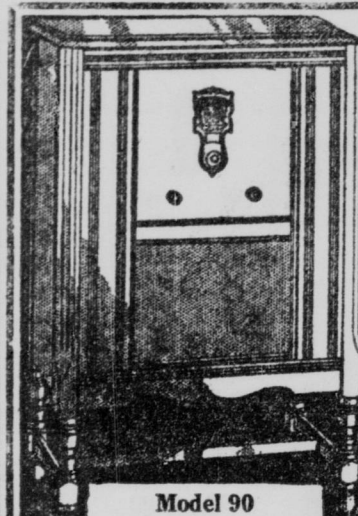

POLICE BADGE LIST PRODUCED

Safety Board Given Names
of 'Courtesy Cops.'

Names of more than 110 persons, who wore courtesy police badges during the Slack administration, were on the list furnished the new board of safety today by the old board.

A number of badges have been returned by persons, whose names were not on the "confidential" list, submitted by the former board on

orders of the Sullivan administra-
tion board.

If the badges are not returned in a reasonable time the board will order police to arrest the holders on charges of impersonating an officer, President Charles Myers said. Holders of the badges are without authority unless they have been sworn in as special officers, Myers said.

Names of several prominent business men, politicians and former city employees were on the list. It was reported to the safety board that some of the badges had been seen on "underworld characters."

Myers said that the board had a record of every badge by number and a careful check will be made to determine those missing.

The governors of Guam, Samoa and Virgin Islands are United States naval officers.

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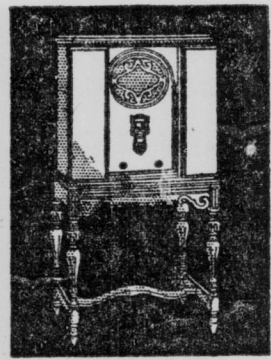

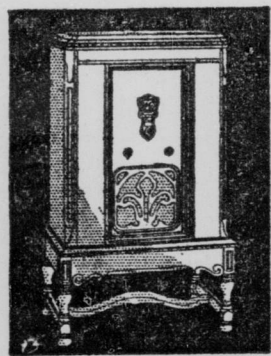

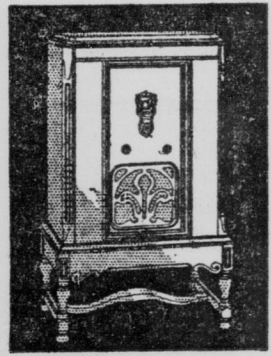
