

HOME DANGER GREATER THAN GANG MENACE

Officer of Safety Council
Cites Many Hazards;
Gives Reasons.

CHICAGO, March 21.—There is no place like home when it comes to risking one's life. In fact, even in Chicago, with its reputation for bad men and gangsters, it is safer to be on the street than it is to hang around the house.

Just how dangerous a place the ordinary home is was told by Dr. Bernice Neuberger, vice-president of the Cleveland Safety Council.

Insurance companies consider home-bodies poor risks, she said, because the law can not enter the home to regulate hours and working conditions.

So many things can happen and these, she asserted, are some of the reasons why:

Runover heels on house shoes.

Piles of old magazines and papers lying about.

Dangerous chemicals left carelessly around.

Use of explosive cleaning fluids.

"Shorted" chains on electric lights.

Electric light bulbs that have burned out and have not been replaced.


