

PREDICTS WORK BOOM IN CITY

U. S. Projects Will Assure
Jobs, Says Ludlow.

Predictions that government building operations now assured for Indianapolis will bring employment for many persons in dire need of work, was made by Representative Louis Ludlow at the meeting of the

Indianapolis Building Congress Thursday at the Severin. The only regrettable feature of the prospect, Ludlow said, is that some months must elapse before these governmental activities can be started.

Ground for the new World war veterans' hospital at Riverside park will be broken in January, and the schedule provides that it be a ten-months' job, Ludlow said.

He declared the labor supply will be recruited here. When congress reconvenes Dec. 1, Ludlow will introduce a bill to increase the appropriation from \$500,000 to \$2,000,000 so that the hospital may be enlarged to a 500-bed capacity. Support of the American Legion, Veterans bureau and other

strong units has been assured for the bill, he said. Ludlow also discussed the construction of a \$1,500,000 New York street addition to the postoffice and declared this will provide much work.

DEPORTATION IS FACING MORAN

'Bugs' May Be Packed Off
to Canada by U. S.

CHICAGO, Oct. 24.—George (Bugs) Moran, the hard-boiled

gangster chieftain who has no gang to lead, may be deported to Canada as an undesirable alien, federal agents said today.

Moran, meanwhile, was free on bond on a vagrancy charge while Judge John P. Lyle's gangsters' nemesis, started an investigation to determine whether Moran obtained his freedom illegally.

In attempting to deport Moran, the federal agents said they would act on a report that he was born in Canada of Irish parentage and that he never had been naturalized in the United States.
