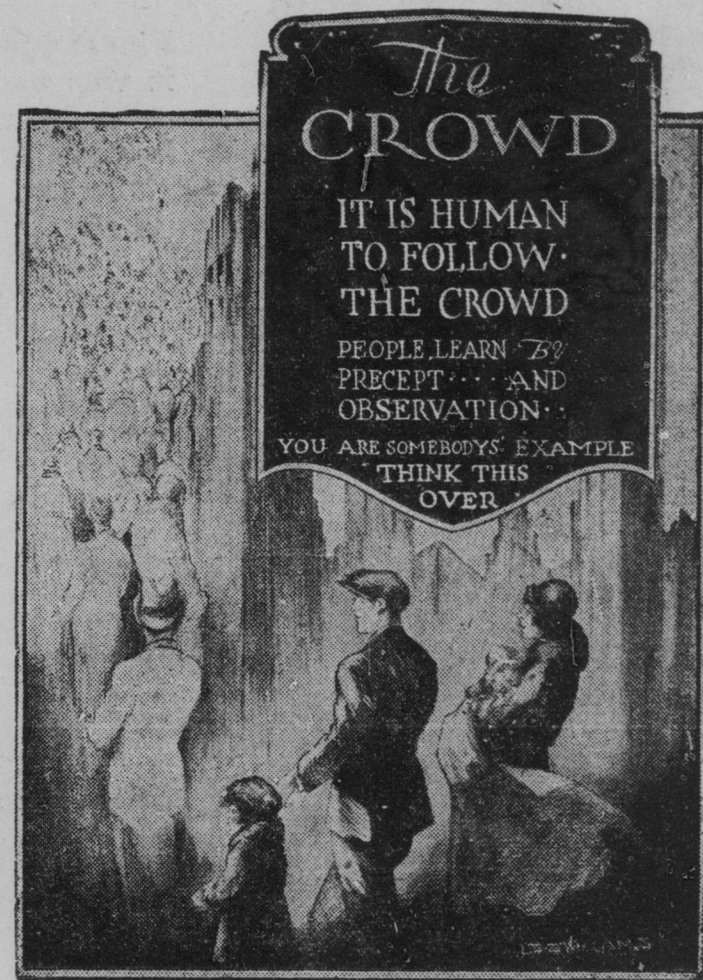
A Message to the Youth of Our City
