

STOCK MARKET LOWER AFTER EARLY UPTURN

Heavy Selling Sends Auburn Down 17 Points; Oils Are Weak.

Average Stock Prices

Average price of thirty industrials for Thursday was 103.12, up from 102.75 on Wednesday. Average of twenty utilities was 116.02, up from 115.75 on Wednesday. Average of forty bonds was 96.58, up from 96.50 on Wednesday.

NEW YORK, March 6.—A series of adverse news items on the oil industry, several poor corporation reports, two important dividends eliminations and expectation of a drop in United States Steel unfilled orders for Feb. 28, brought the stock market down 1 to 7 points today.

Trading volume was about a million shares above the total of Thursday. Selling predominated, although there was a firmer tone at the opening and in the early trading. This was helped by a decline of \$8,000,000 in brokerage loans, indicating that stocks were passing from weak to strong hands, and a report from the treasury department that the March offering of \$1,400,000,000 had been oversubscribed by more than \$2,000,000,000.

New Lows Made. Selling was particularly heavy in the recent volatile favorites such as Auburn Auto, which had been carried to new 1931 highs mostly on short covering. Auburn crashed nearly 17 points to around 182, while Case lost nearly 3 to around 107, and Worthington Pump 6 to 88.

Western Union broke 7 points to 130, equaling the low for the year on selling based on expectation of a poor 1930 report. Studebaker lost more than a point of its 1930 report showing only 3.6 cents a share earned, against \$5.69 a share in 1929. American Rolling Mill broke on its earnings for 1930 of only 3 cents a share, against \$4.24 in 1929. Arcor directors passed the dividend.

Oils were faced by bad news, including reductions in various sections in gasoline and crude oil prices. Standard of New Jersey dipped to a new low for the year at 43 1/2 on news the general education board, founded by John D. Rockefeller, had unloaded a large block of the stock. Texas Corporation, selling ex-dividend, lost more than 2 points and other issues of the group fractions to 2 points.

Rail Shares React. Railroad shares reacted, but declines were in a smaller range. Fears of further dividend reductions in this group were still prevalent. Among the special issues which dropped with Case and Worthington were Vanadium, A. M. Byers, Mullins Manufacturing, Eastman Kodak, Foster Wheeler, Columbian Carbon and Johns Manville, all of them being off 2 to 6 points.

Call money renewed at 1 1/2 per cent and held there until 1:30, end of the fourth hour when the rate was boosted to 2 per cent, equaling Thursday's close. Grains were steady to firm. Cotton eased off slightly.
