

## JIMMY WALKER FACING LAXITY PROBE THREAT

Specific Charges Said to Be  
Drafted Against N. Y.  
Mayor.

NEW YORK, March 11.—Mayor James J. Walker, who left two days ago for California to "get away from all these investigations," faced the possibility today of becoming a target of the probe of the investigation.

The movement for a general investigation of the whole Tammany-controlled city government, which gained great impetus with the start of an inquiry into incompetency charges against Thomas C. T. Crain, district attorney, may be broadened to include the mayor.

The Society for the Prevention of Crime, in a letter to individual members of the legislature, has cited specific charges against Walker, understood to be of the same nature, laxity and incompetency, as those against Crain.

It was rumored that the City Club, author of the formal charges against Crain, also is considering filing charges against the mayor.

### Urge United Front

At the same time the New York City Congregational Church Association, representing forty-two churches, moved for united protests by Protestants, Catholics and Jews against civic corruption. A resolution was adopted Tuesday night asking Governor Franklin D. Roosevelt to take immediate action.

The resolution declared it is the "religious duty of every citizen to assist in creating such public sentiment as will not tolerate bribery and will demand honesty in all quarters of civic life."

Meanwhile, the Vivian Gordon murder case, one of the direct causes of the whole outburst against the city administration, produced a sensation for the first time in several days, but apparently was still no nearer a solution than when it first started.

### Gordon Records Vanish

The records of an examination of Miss Gordon, murdered witness in the Seabury vice inquiry and alleged racketeer, by Owen W. Bohan, assistant district attorney, in 1928 during an investigation of a stock fraud case, have disappeared from the office of District Attorney Crain, it was learned.

The case concerned Joseph Radlow, Samuel Cohen and Lee Katz, who were indicted on charges of grand larceny. Miss Gordon, appearing at that time as a voluntary witness, told Bohan that Radlow had demanded her out of \$50,000 and that she was "in fear of him."

Radlow is a cousin of John A. Radloff, attorney for the slain woman, who is held with Cohen in jail as a material witness in the murder case.

### WALES 'SALES' TOUR FAILS TO WORRY U. S.

South American Tour Not  
Likely to Affect Much  
Trade, Says Experts.

WASHINGTON, March 11.—American business interest and

government officials are watching with interest the South American tour of the prince of Wales and Prince George, but they apparently are not worried at the bid of the heir of the British empire for Latin-American trade.

The prince was in South America four years ago, and British imports gradually have developed since that time, while United States trade gradually increased.

All trade is off now with the world-wide depression, but the United States continues to get the larger share.

The prince took his own car to South America this time. He made the mistake before of riding down the gaily decorated streets of Buenos Aires in a celebration in an

American car. The picture was spread widely in this country.

He did make part of his tour this time in an American airplane.

Princes of other nations—and even Mr. Hoover while President-elect—have been on "good-will" tours to South America in the last few years.

Hard-boiled business men and government officials who chart those things say their effect in the long run is negligible. There may be a temporary spurt, they say, but it dies away.

"These drives have met with varying success in the past," is the way Julius Klein, assistant secretary of commerce puts it today.

Klein is ready to stack the permanent and continuing work of

American firms in South America against the results of the fated junctet of the handsome and attractive young man who some day will be king of England.

The type of American representatives has changed from the swash-buckling pioneer from the states to well-mannered and well-educated young men who blend diplomacy with business acumen.

United States trade with South America dropped from \$2,000,000 in 1929 to \$1,467,000,000 in 1930. Imports were off 29.47 per cent and exports, 29.46 per cent. These are figures of value. The drop in volume was considerably less.
