

## RUSSIA BACK IN WORLD MARKET; U. S. AFFECTED

Exports Jump 14 Per Cent  
Under Stimulus of  
5-Year Plan.

WASHINGTON, March 19.—Ex-  
tent of Soviet Russia's sudden and  
surprising re-entry into the world  
market, under the stimulus of her  
five-year economic development plan  
and its widespread effect on many  
countries, including the United  
States, was disclosed in a survey  
today.

Russia's exports jumped 14 per  
cent to a total of \$501,000,000 dur-  
ing the last fiscal year, closing Sep-  
tember, 1930, figures published today  
by the commerce department  
showed.

Notable increases were shown in  
wheat, oil, coal and lumber, all of  
which compete with major products  
of this country.

The keen interest of the United  
States in the five-year plan and  
its effect on the United States and  
the whole Russian experiment is  
reflected in the investigation or-  
dered by Secretary of State Stim-  
son and the close watch kept by  
commerce department officials on  
every development.

Widespread agitation in congress  
last session for embargoes on Rus-  
sian products is expected to be re-  
newed at the next session.

Russia's re-entry into the world  
economic picture after several years  
of quiescence while the Soviet ex-  
periment was getting under way,  
particularly is perturbing to econ-  
omists because she is "dumping"  
her products at prices far below the  
cost of production in other coun-  
tries.

This she is enabled to do by the  
Communist method of cheap pro-  
duction under government monop-  
oly.

by the Indianapolis section of the  
International Workers Order in

## FARMS' PRICE HIKE SEEN IN NEXT DECADE

Good Land Is Safe for  
Future Investments,  
Parley Told.

Prediction that good farm lands  
should increase greatly in price  
within the next ten years was made  
today by A. G. Brown, president of  
the Federal Land Bank of Louis-  
ville, addressing nearly 300 rep-  
resentatives of national farm loan  
associations of Indiana at the Clay-  
pool.

"While good farm lands should  
be safe investments in the future,  
poor farm lands will continue to  
present a problem," he asserted.

"The fundamental quality of  
farms either from operation or in-  
vestment standpoint is reflected in  
the fact our bank, which makes  
long-term amortized first mortgage  
loans in Ohio, Indiana, Kentucky  
and Tennessee, has continued to sell  
farms during one of the worst de-  
pressions agriculture ever has ex-  
perienced."

The meeting, attended by officers  
of the 116 national farm loan asso-  
ciations in Indiana, which have 16-  
625 loans totaling \$59,445,000 out-  
standing, was for the purpose of  
exchanging ideas in an effort to  
increase the number of loans in the  
state.

The associations are formed by  
ten or more farmers who take stock  
in the association to the extent of  
5 per cent of their loans. The as-  
sociation uses this money to buy  
stock in the Federal Bank of Louis-  
ville which advances the loan  
money.

## SEPARATE NAVY PACT DRAFTED

Italian-French Accord Not  
in 5-Power Treaty.

LONDON, March 19.—Experts of  
Britain, France and Italy begin to-  
day the drafting of the new naval  
accord limiting French and Italian  
armaments as a separate agree-  
ment from the five-power London  
naval treaty.

At the same time, it was learned  
that as a result of the conferences  
of Senator Dwight W. Morrow and  
Ambassador Charles G. Dawes at  
the foreign office, fears were held  
that the new pact would affect the  
Washington naval treaty, especial-  
ly in regard to the new accord on  
construction of battleships.  
France obtains an additional  
6,000 tons of battleships as com-  
pared to her quota under the  
Washington treaty. In reliable  
American sources it was pointed  
out that the effects on the Wash-

ington treaty would be of minor  
character, however, and would de-  
pend chiefly on the average ships  
which France decides to scrap.

It was further said in reliable  
sources that the United States has  
been disinclined to agree with the  
British plans for reviewing the  
London naval treaty of 1930 and  
other armament pacts at the world  
disarmament conference at Geneva  
next February.

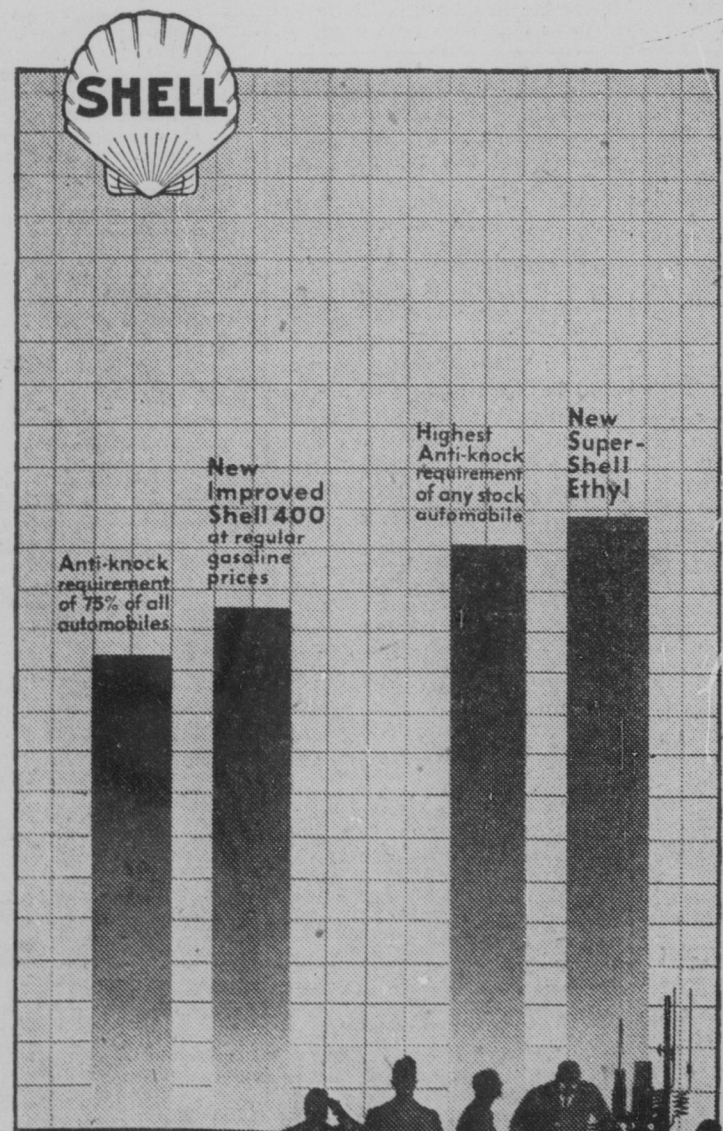
