NEW YORK, April 2.—Make a fashion check-up on men's neckties on Easter and what will you find?

Not so many loud ties. Nor wild ones. Nor hit-you-in-the-eye ones. But they won't be dull either. They'll have plenty of color. But it will be well-chosen color. Shades that look right with the suit. And they'll be neat and reasonable looking. No crazy zigzags or patchwork quilts.

The most fashionable tie for spring—good because so many men prefer it—is the small-patterned tie. Small all over designs. Small geometrical patterns. Small floral patterns. Pin-dots and polka dots. Small indefinite checks and plaids. They're way up among the favorites because they look best with most suits and shirts and faces. They're easy to knot. They're neither dead dull nor all set for a joy ride.

Next in order of choice—and fashion—are the striped ties. Simple, good-looking, conservative stripes. No prison stripes or candy stripes or stars and stripes. But simple... that's the big thing in striped ties this spring.

Just about the liveliest are the regimental stripes—stripes in the traditional colors of famous British regiments. Then there are clusters of pin stripes and quarter and half-

inch bar stripes placed not too distantly apart.

Combination of wide and narrow stripes, too, using white stripes, satin stripes and more stripes. If you want the wide open spaces, you'll get them in another popular tie that won over lots of men during the winter. The spaced pattern tie.

Squares, circles and similar geometrics or sporting figures such as golf balls and dots are spaced at intervals. Not too wide and open, though. Arranged so as to let one or two of the figures show in the knot.

The conservative plain colored tie still ranks among the leaders. And medium and darker shades of blue are most popular in this tie, as well as for backgrounds of patterned ties.

Other colors, favorites because they look well with suit colors and materials are tan and medium greens; gray, or black-and-white that gives a gray effect; and dark reds.

Ties are knotted this spring in a medium-size knot. Not as small as you've seen it in the past. But not as large, either, as was worn a few years ago at many universities.

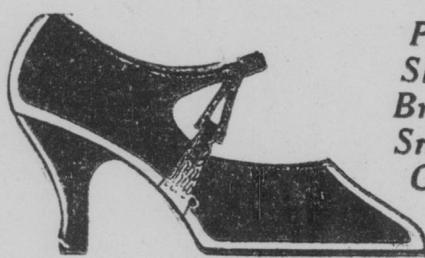
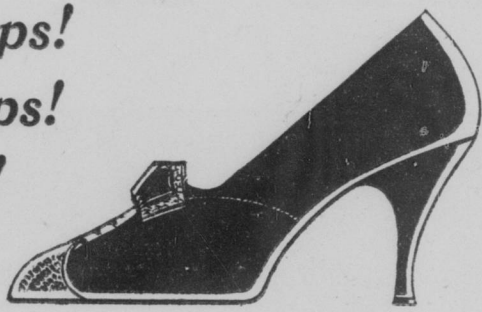

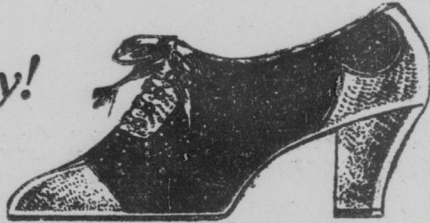

## Delay Girl Scout Outing

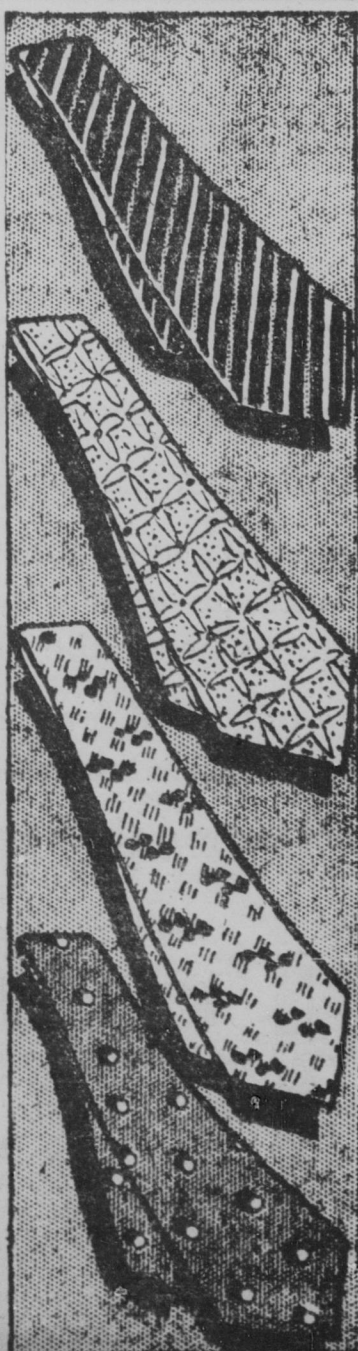
The Girl Scout outing to have been held Wednesday at Camp Dellwood was postponed because of the weather. Scout officials have announced that it will be held Friday.
