

HITLER FIGHTS SPLIT PERILING FASCIST PARTY

German Leader Denies Reports Rebellion Is 'Beginning of the End.'

MUNICH, Germany, April 3.—Adolph Hitler, leader of the Fascist party, announced today a "thorough cleansing" of his political organization, which he said quickly would suppress the rebellious factions within its ranks.


Hitler, attacking the eastern German rebel group which has threatened to disrupt the party, issued a manifesto warning that "anybody executing or tolerating the commands or instructions of Walter Stennes (the rebel leader) automatically excludes himself from the party."

He said the defection would be suppressed within "a few days" and that it already was "dwindling."

"A thorough cleansing of the party of all unreliable elements is imminent," the manifesto said.

Many political observers have believed that the rebellion against Hitler's leadership, due to his recent modification of extremist policies, would lead to the complete disintegration of the party.



HOOVER DEFIED BY SEMINOLES OF EVERGLADES

Refuse to Recognize an Appointment by Hoover of Tribal Chief.

MIAMI, Fla., April 3.—Florida's Seminole Indians have refused to recognize an appointment by President Hoover.

The President recently appointed an Indian known as Chill Fish to be chief of the Seminoles for one day, effective on or before June 30, to sign deeds relating to certain tribal lands. Under the commission he was to receive \$10 for his labor and expenses not exceeding \$5.

The Seminoles learned of the appointment and protested to Cory Osceola, grandson of the famous Chief Osceola and now acting chief of the tribe, that Chill Fish is an Oklahoma Indian and not entitled to sit at their tribal fires.

Cory has advised the President that land transfers affecting the Florida Seminoles and bearing the signature of Chill Fish will not be recognized.

His telegram:

"To President Hoover: Florida Seminole Indians learned

from White Friends today about naming Oklahoma Indian as chief of the Seminole nation in land sales in Florida. Seminoles do not know about transfer to be made and want to know if lands are in

"If so, the transfers will not be recognized or considered by the Florida Seminoles. We are satisfied with our home in the Everglades. Our forefathers held this land against the white man and we have lived on it ever since.

"We do not agree to anything we have not asked anything but to be let alone in possession of the land from which the white man failed to drive us in 1837."

Osceola has distrusted white men ever since a group appeared at his camp and attempted to persuade him to sign papers which they said would give them the oil rights on Seminole property. He agreed to negotiate through his lawyer only and this the promoters were said to have refused to do.


