The newspaper said that representatives from Scotland Yard would board the liner Paris at Plymouth next Thursday and notify her that she "is unwanted."

It had been reported that Texas Guinan intended to come to London and start a night club.

100 MILLIONS TO BE REFUNDED IN TAXES

Vast Sum Appropriated by Congress Available on July 1.

WASHINGTON, May 22.—Other government departments are planning economies and legislators are discussing tax increases, but the bureau of internal revenue will be ready on July 1 to refund nearly a hundred million dollars in taxes.

When the new fiscal year begins in a few weeks, \$26,000,000 appropriated by the last congress for tax refunds will become available. This, combined with unexpended balances of earlier appropriations, will raise the fund to about \$97,000,000.

Treasury officials have estimated that tax refunds during the next fiscal year will total \$96,492,000, including interest.




