

'WHITEWASH' IS GIVEN ILLINOIS 'PEN' OFFICIALS

Nothing Wrong in State's Penal System, Legislators' Riot Report Says.

SPRINGFIELD, Ill., May 28.—A

legislative committee which spent

weeks investigating a series of

prison riots in Illinois was on offi-

cial record today as believing that

in the main there is nothing wrong

with the state's penal system, and

that no official or group of officials

can be blamed for the uprisings.

Among suggestions in a report

submitted to the house was one that

it might be better to reduce the

size of the pardon and parole board,

which now has nine members, and

which the committee thought might

be "unwieldy."

The committee did not uphold

charges that either the board or

the board's application of the state's

indeterminate sentence law was re-

sponsible for riots in which several

were killed and more than half a

million dollars' worth of property

destroyed at Joliet and Stateville.

The committee praised the pardon

board and Warden Henry C. Hill.

The report stated that the killing

of three convicts in an escape at-

tempt several months ago was "un-

necessary and could have been

avoided."
