

ECONOMY RULE NOT TO AFFECT U. S. DRY ARMY

Prohibition Chief Unable to
Find Any Place for
Reductions.

WASHINGTON, June 19.—Prohibition enforcement is to be exempted from President Herbert Hoover's economy campaign, it was disclosed today.

Neither Attorney General Mitchell nor Federal Prohibition Director Amos W. W. Woodcock have been able to find where any reduction in expenditures can be made. A total of around \$50,000,000 yearly is required for federal prohibition enforcement activities.

The main endeavor will be to keep enforcement funds down to their present level. Woodcock said he would ask congress for an increase in appropriation at the next session, but it is indicated plainly there will be no decrease.

There was some thought that the new enforcement campaign which opens next month with 350 additional dry agents might lead Woodcock to ask for still another addition to the federal force at the next congress, but it is too early to determine this, he said.

Opposed to Force Cut

Congress appropriated \$11,369,500 for the federal prohibition bureau, an increase of \$2,369,500 over appropriations for the previous year. Most of the increase was for 500 new agents. Already 150 of these have been put to work. The others are to begin operations about the middle of July after two weeks of schooling.

Activities of the prohibition bureau cover only a part of prohibition enforcement costs. A sizable part of funds for the coast guard, customs bureau and justice department go for prohibition enforcement, bringing the total to around \$50,000,000.

Woodcock is enthusiastic over the campaign he will begin in the next few days with his greatly increased force, and he would contest vigorously any attempt to cut down this force and restrict the drive that he has planned so carefully.

Expansion Necessary

Mitchell said he saw no change of any appreciable economies in his department, which receives about \$50,000,000 a year, less than most of the other federal departments.

He explained that there has been a necessary expansion in facilities of the department, and even now there is further need for expansion.

Courts still are congested, especially with prohibition cases. It has been necessary to have additional men to handle the larger dockets. The federal penitentiaries, too, are overtaxed, and additional building will be required in the near future.

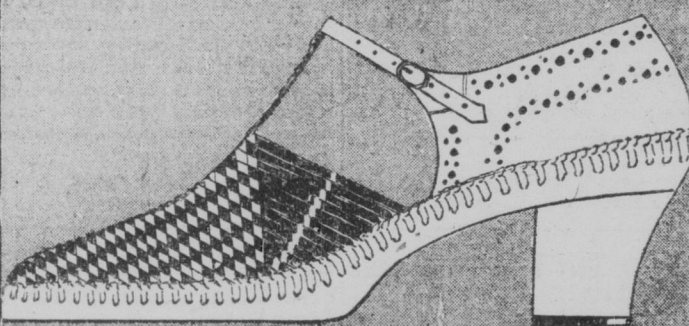
