

Fillies in Rich Event

Top Flight Favorite of Big Field; Leiter Stable Reinstated.

CHICAGO, July 8.—Top Flight, owned by C. V. (Sonny) Whitney, was a 5-2 favorite to capture the \$10,000 added Lassie stakes for 2-year-old fillies at Arlington park race track today.

Twenty-five fillies were named over night for the five-and-one-half-furlong race. If all twenty-five go to the post, the race will have a gross value of \$23,150, and the winner will get \$24,530.

Joseph Leiter, millionaire sportsman, who was suspended and fined \$250 a week ago, has been restored to good standing and his three fillies, Princess Ives, Princess A. O. and Princess Camella, were eligible for today's race. Leiter apologized Tuesday for remarks made to the stewards after Princess Camella was disqualified in a race last week.

In addition to Top Flight, the outstanding contenders in the Lassie stakes are Bonaparte, Butter Beans, At Sunrise, Polonaise, Gala Flight, Dark Seeker, Lady Teddy and Princess Camella.
