

NEW BAR RULES ANNOUNCED BY CHIEF JUSTICE

State Examining Board
Members Are Named
by Martin.

New rules for admission to the bar, now completely under jurisdiction of the Indiana supreme court and personnel of the new state bar examining board were made public today by Chief Justice Clarence R. Martin of the supreme court. The law making the supreme court the arbiter of admissions was passed by the 1931 legislature and became effective July 1. State examining board, appointed by the court, consists of an attorney from each of the five judicial districts from which judges for the high court are chosen. Members appointed by the court are as follows: First district, Pro-

fessor Bernard C. Gavit of Indiana university law school, Bloomington; Second district, Julian Sharpnack, Columbus; Third district, Remster A. Bingham, Indianapolis; Fourth district, Milo N. Feightner, Huntington, and Fifth district, Lenn J. Oare, South Bend. Under the rules, the board shall conduct examinations for candidates for admission to practice at Indianapolis on the first Monday in March and October and the second Monday in July. The board will elect its own offi-

cers and a \$15 examination and admission fee must be deposited with the supreme court clerk when applicants file, at least three weeks before the examinations are held. The fee and copy of the application will be forwarded by the clerk to the secretary of the examining board. A committee on character and fitness in each district, consisting of

at least one attorney from each county and the district board member, is to be appointed. Rules provide for a roll of attorneys as of July 2, 1931, consisting of all attorneys therefore admitted to the supreme court. Admission without examination is provided for all attorneys admitted to their respective circuit courts prior to July 2, 1931. Admission without examination also is provided for the tem-

porary practice of foreign attorneys, and for the general practices of foreign attorneys of three years standing who have become voters of this state.
