

## NAB SUSPECT IN FRAUD SCHEME

### Alleged Swindler Held for Louisville Cops.

William H. Brooks, 41, alleged swindler who has been sought throughout the nation several

months, is held by Indianapolis police today for Louisville authorities.

He was arrested Tuesday afternoon on information provided by T. M. Overley, head of the Better Business Bureau, who claimed Brooks was attempting to operate in the city.

According to police information, Brooks posed as the branch manager of a coal or advertising company. He advertised for assistant managers. Applicants were asked either to provide \$300 for bond or

purchase a similar amount of stock, it is charged.

When Brooks had sufficient applicants and their money he fled the cities and reopened elsewhere, it is charged.

Brooks was residing at 729 North New Jersey street with George P. Brooks, 39, said to be his brother. Police charged George Brooks with vagrancy.

## BAY SEARCHED FOR MAIL PILOT

### Ship-Shore Plane Believed Wrecked in Sea.

TRURO, N. S., Oct. 7.—Small fishing boats and an airplane searched

Cobeguid bay today for the bodies of Fritz Simon and Rudolph Wagenknecht, pilot and mechanic, respectively, of a ship-to-shore mail plane from the liner Bremen that apparently crashed in the bay early on Tuesday.

Simon and Wagenknecht, in the seaplane, New York, were catapulted from the Bremen Monday, 700 miles off Newfoundland, and headed for New York with five bags of mail. They stopped at Glace Bay, N. S., to refuel and paused again at Sydney, from where they

took off in the face of adverse weather reports. They did not reach New York.

The lighthouse keeper at Burnt-coast light heard an explosion and crash, followed by cries for help, from the direction of the bay early Tuesday. An all-day search resulted in the finding of a plane's motor, presumably that of the New

York.




