them and said this means there are 24,000,000 people in distress.

The Costigan-La Follette bill was introduced by the Rev. Father John O'Grady, secretary of the National Catholic Charities, who said it met the views of social welfare organizations.

Huddleston said: "Many responsible families throughout the rural districts in the south are living on cornbread and molasses, and have no clothes."

He added that millions of Negroes in the rural districts are suffering for lack of food.

The final congressional obstacle to immediate operation of the \$2,000,000,000 reconstruction finance corporation was cleared away today by the senate, which waived its rules to permit President Hoover to be notified at once of its confirmation of three appointive directors.

The three directors now may be commissioned by the President and administered the oath of office. This makes a quorum of six of the seven directors. The three directors, confirmed last Saturday, are Charles G. Dawes, Harvey Couch and Jesse Jones.

Nomination of the seventh director, Wilson McCarthy of Salt Lake City, was received by the senate today.

Rigid restriction of short-selling in grains was approved today by the house agriculture committee.

It endorsed the tentative draft of a measure which would limit short sales to 1,000,000 bushels and authorize the secretary of agriculture to reduce this amount or stop short-selling entirely in times of emergency.

The senate today passed without amendment and sent to the White House for signature, the \$125,000,000 appropriation to increase capital stock of federal farm loan banks, under the second completed bill of President Hoover's reconstruction program.

One of the sharpest fights over national defense in many years will break out on the house floor this week, when Democrats present a rigidly curtailed war department appropriation bill.

Sharing the limelight with this certain storm will be a continuing controversy over the form of a tax increase bill, behind the doors of the ways and means committee.

The war department bill was expected to come to the house floor Thursday.
