

**DETROIT'S REDS
DEFIANT; PLAN
MASS FUNERAL**

60 Held, 5 Leaders Sought
in Aftermath of Riots in
Which 4 Were Killed.

DETROIT, March 9.—Communists
defied police today with plans to
hold a "mass funeral" for their four
comrades slain when a mob of un-
employed stormed the Ford River
Rouge plant.

To precede the funeral, the radi-
cal organization announced prepara-
tions for a meeting Friday to out-
line future demonstrations similar to
the one which, police allege, led to
the fatal rioting Tuesday. The meet-
ing and funeral will be held in
Arena Gardens.

Authorities pushed their inquiry
into the causes of the march on
Dearborn.

Sixty alleged members of the mob
were held in the Wayne county jail
while police asked federal authori-
ties to aid in apprehending five
Communists accused of inci-
tating the riot by inflammatory
speeches.

Prosecutor Harry S. Toy said he
would press a grand jury investiga-
tion to obtain indictments under the
Michigan criminal syndicalism law.
He named as four of the alleged
leaders wanted: William Z. Foster,
national Communist leader; William
Reynolds, who recently was
sentenced to ninety days in the De-
troit House of Correction for lead-
ing a demonstration in Pontiac,
Mich.; John Schles, former Com-
munist candidate for mayor of De-
troit; Albert Goetz, a reputed mem-
ber of the Lincoln park unemployed
council.

Police Chief Carl Brooks of Dear-
born asked the United States gov-
ernment to assist in fixing respon-
sibility for the march. The suburban
city council commanded police for
their "cool judgment and heroic ef-
forts in stopping the riot."






