

REBUKE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN MANN FIGHT

Council Deletes Paragraph
in Ordinance Flaying
Highway Head.

Efforts of county commissioners to discredit Charles Mann, Republican highway superintendent, in their fight to oust him, today received a rebuke from the county council.

Councilmen amended an appropriation ordinance by striking out a paragraph charging that Mann had been guilty of neglect of duty.

"This body does not believe that any ordinance should contain criticism of any public official," Walter

C. Boettcher, council president, stated.

The council passed an ordinance, which commissioners requested, appropriating \$188,509 in highway funds, but struck out another paragraph stating the council had approved the commissioners' 1-cent road levy.

"This body did not approve that levy. We wanted it cut to a half cent, but they told us we had no jurisdiction in the matter," Boettcher explained.

A bitter fight ensued between councilmen and commissioners at budget-making time last fall. Mann, highway superintendent, suggested a 1-cent levy as sufficient for 1932, which was raised by commissioners.

Attempt to oust Mann, launched by Democratic Commissioners Dow Vorhies and Thomas Ellis, has ended in circuit court to which Mann appealed his case.

The fight caused commissioners to hold up wages of more than 200 road workers. These men, whose families have been dependent upon charity, will be paid from funds appropriated today.

ASKS RAILROAD RIGHTS TO USE OF WATERWAYS

R. H. Aishton Opposes U. S.
Aid for River and
Harbor Work.

WASHINGTON, May 26.—The suggestion that the railroads be given the right to engage in inland waterways transportation, was made to the house ways and means committee today by R. H. Aishton of the Association of Railway executives.

He appeared in opposition to the Mansfield bill for a \$500,000,000 bond issue for rivers and harbors projects.

He charged "that an appreciable

amount" of taxes paid by railroads made possible many waterway improvements, and that rail carriers would remain opposed to waterways competition "which is relieved from important operating costs."

The government should retire from barge line operation in two years, Aishton said.

C. S. Duncan, economist of the association, submitted statistical data to the committee, and charged that tonnage figures of barge lines were distorted.

"The great bulk of inland waterways tonnage is short haul," said Duncan, "this looks as large tonnage, but is low as to mileage, which really measures service."
