

# U.S. FILES BILL LISTING TOTAL WORLEY INCOME

Particulars of Government Case Explained: Stay Granted.

An itemized bill of particulars, setting out the government's case against Claude M. Worley on income tax evasion charges, was filed in federal court Monday by the district attorney's office, as Judge Robert C. Baltzell granted a two-day continuance in the trial of the former Indianapolis police chief.

The trial will be held June 22, instead of June 20, Baltzell announced, to allow Michael Ryan, one of Worley's attorneys, to attend a political convention.

The government's bill of particulars listed Worley's total income during 1927, 1928, 1929 and 1930 as \$91,368.44. Bank deposits of \$3,135.70 are listed as having been made by Worley in 1927, including checks for \$240 from the Central Trust Company of Illinois; \$250 from Edward Traugott; \$55 from the Hoosier Motor Club and \$60 from Edward Traugott.

Twelve purchases of Liberty bonds were listed, nine of them by Mike Maroney and three by Jacob Wolf. The bonds were valued by the government at \$21,019.16.

The bill listed Worley's income in 1928 at \$12,544.08, including \$10,321.60 in Liberty bonds bought through Mike Maroney. Gross income for 1929 was estimated at \$30,670.18, and for 1929 at \$10,307.60.

Worley is charged with having failed to file correct returns as required by law, and with having failed to pay taxes of more than \$4,000 on a taxable income of approximately \$86,000.

# MARSHAL ISSUES FIREWORKS EDICT

Hogston Details 'Innocent' Noise Makers That Are Condemned.

Issuing his annual rules for the handling of Fourth of July fireworks, State Fire Marshal Alfred E. Hogston today gave a list of "innocent looking things" which are on the condemned list and must not be sold.

Declaring them to be "powerful enough to seriously injure and possibly kill," the fire marshal forbade the sale of the following in the interest of public safety:

Victory Globe flash salute, K-O flash salute, O-K flash salute, Radio salute, Glitta Crax, spit devil, son-of-a-gun, devil-on-the-walk, No. 0, 1, 2 white snakes (poisonous), hot air paper ball balloons (all sizes).

Rules governing display, sale, handling and storage of fireworks is effective June 15, as follows:

No fireworks shall be put on display before June 20. This display must be done in such a way that there will be no danger of the goods being exploded by the rays of the sun or other agency, and under such conditions that if from any cause they are exploded, it will not cause the building to get afire.

This can be done by putting such fireworks in a non-inflammable container completely enclosed above, below and on all sides, except the front, in the display window.

No fireworks shall be displayed or sold on the streets, sidewalks, alleys, yards, vacant lots or other such places in any city or town of the state.

All dealers must keep all fireworks stored in non-inflammable containers, if the original shipping cases have been unpacked before June 20.

No fireworks that are capable of causing serious injury to the person by explosion shall be sold.

No fireworks shall be sold to children under 12 years of age.

No fireworks shall be sold or exploded at any public firing station or bulk station of Class 1 and 2 inflammable liquids.

Sales by retail merchants may begin on June 20, but no deliveries of fireworks shall be made until July 1.

The department reserves the right to terminate the sale display and storage of fireworks by any person doing the same in a careless, negligent manner, or violating any of these rules.
