

ELKS LEAVING SATURDAY FOR LODGE SESSION

Past Exalted Rulers to Lead Delegation to Birmingham.

Party composed of members of the Elks lodges in Indiana, their families and friends, headed by Hubert S. Riley and J. C. Gribben, past exalted rulers of the order, will leave Indianapolis Saturday to attend the sixty-eighth grand lodge convention at Birmingham, Ala., July 9 to 15.

The train will leave the Union station at 2:10 p. m. Delegates from southern Indiana will join the party at Shively, Greensburg and Cincinnati. The group will be entertained at the Elks home in Cincinnati at night. Leaving Cincinnati at 10 p. m. the party will arrive in Chattanooga early Sunday morning. A sight-seeing tour will be made through Chattanooga, to Lookout mountain, Chickamauga park, and Lookout mountain caverns. Leaving Chattanooga at 5:20 p. m. the train will arrive in Birmingham at 9:30. Indiana headquarters there will be the Hotel Thomas Jefferson.

Grand lodge officers will arrive in Birmingham Saturday. Sunday special services will be held in local churches for the visitors. A pilgrimage to the grave of B. M. Allen, past grand exalted ruler, in Elwood cemetery, will be made Sunday afternoon. The memorial address will be delivered by John R. Coen, grand exalted ruler.

At 2 there will be a reception and entertainment at the Birmingham country club. The "Purple Bubble Ball," one of the high spots of the convention, will be held at the Municipal auditorium at 9 p. m. as a testimonial to grand exalted ruler Coen and Mrs. Coen.

As on previous mornings, business, automobile tours, golf, trap-shooting, drill contests and band contests will take the attention of the Elks on Wednesday morning.

Another feature of the convention will occur at 9 p. m., when 300 Negro singers present the "Dixie Jubilee" of spirituals and Negro melodies. Included in this program will be a number of selections by Alexander's Ragtime band of fifty members.

At 4 p. m., Thursday, July 14, the grand lodge parade at the Legion field will be held. The convention will end with "Auld Lang Syne" ball in Municipal auditorium at 9.

The local delegation expects to return to Indianapolis July 15. In addition to the party going to Birmingham by train, a number of members and their families will travel by automobile. Gribben is official representative of the local lodge at the convention.
