## DRY ORATOR'S WHIP STINGS OLD PARTIES

Prohibition Party Opens Its National Convention in Tabernacle.

the dry Democrats confirm the charge of bigotry hurled against them in that year for bolting a wet Catholic candidate and supporting now a wetter Protestant?

If they do, the Lord have mercy on the rebuked souls.

"As a late Hoover Republican, I would prefer, if the liquor traffic is to come back, that it be brought by the party of Smith, Raskob and Roosevelt than by the party of Abraham Lincoln. I decline the invitation to ride into the White House on the trial rail of Al Smith with a Republican label.

The Republican national committee was divided into two camps, the winging wets and the swobblers. There were no drys, as we understand the use of the word, in the convention that four years ago adopted a platform for maintenance and enforcement of the eighteenth amendment. Not a voice was heard but that of Esau, ready to sell the birthright of the party for a mess of politics.

### Compared to Babel

There never was greater confusion of tongues since the building of the Tower of Babel than the interpretation of the Republican leaders, wet and dry, and the Republican press, of the plank on prohibition.

It avoids the word repeal, but provides the method of repeal.

This is the most puerile example of ducking and dodging and duplicity in the history of American politics. It offers freedom from the saloon to the drys and freedom from prohibition to the wets.

It is a complete surrender to the saloon wherever they want it, and abandonment of national prohibition, the thing for which we have fought and finally won, after three generations."

The delegates still were up in the air about a presidential choice. Feeling that Borah had told Colvin he did not desire to head the Prohibition party ticket is prevalent, and they are casting about for an aggressive leader.

### Butler Is Mentioned

Name of Smedley Butler, major-general of marines, retired, who was dry candidate for the Republican nomination for United States senator in Pennsylvania, was given much mention, but Colvin said Butler is the party's candidate for senator in his home state.

Arthur Barnhart of Chicago, commander of the Saracens, a prohibition, young men's organization fighting the repeal group known as the Crusaders, was scheduled to be a speaker at the resolutions committee meeting this afternoon.

Three former party presidential nominees will be principal speakers at the open session of the convention tonight in the tabernacle.

They are: L. A.aron S. Watkins of Lima, O., 1920 nominee; Herman P. Faris of Clinton, Miss., 1924 choice, and William F. Varnay of New York, 1928 candidate.

### Booms Ford—for Money

WASHINGTON, July 5.—A suggestion that the Prohibition party, now in convention at Indianapolis, nominate Henry Ford and insure a \$1,000,000 campaign fund, was made today by James Martin Miller, who said he was a former Ford employee on the staff of the Dearborn Independent.

Miller telegraphed his suggestion to D. Leigh Colvin, chairman of the convention.

## 1,500 TURN OUT FOR C. M. T. C.

Month's Training Starts at Fort Wednesday.

Wartime activities were recalled today at Ft. Benjamin Harrison with mobilization of an army of Citizens' Military Training Camp candidates reported for a month's military instruction with the Eleventh Infantry.

More than 1,500 youths had reported at the fort today. Instruction will be started Wednesday.

Eleventh infantry officers and enlisted personnel, together with the medical corps and officers of the three hundred thirty-first reserve infantry regiment examined the recruits, issued army uniforms and assigned the rookies to organizations.

Part of the candidate are being quartered in barracks of the Third Battalion, Eleventh infantry, and the Third field artillery, now at Ft. Knox on summer training camp duty, and the remainder will occupy tents.

Ohio reserve officers will instruct the youths until July 17, when the Eleventh infantry will take over the work.

### TWO WOMEN INJURED AS AUTO HITS POLE

Mrs. Carrie Brim, Mrs. Ella Wills Are Hurt Seriously.

When an automobile in which they were riding struck a utility pole and destroyed nearly twenty feet of wire fence on state road No. 52, ten miles east of the city, today, Mrs. Carrie Brim, 32, and Mrs. Ella Wills, 38 both of 411 West Pratt street were injured seriously.

Mr. Brim, husband of one of the injured women, escaped without injuries, although the auto was demolished.

Mr. Brim told deputy sheriffs that his car was forced off the road by a motorist coming in the opposite direction. The motorist failed to stop as Brim's car veered off the road.

Mrs. Brim incurred severe lacerations on the chest, back, face and legs, and Mrs. Wills suffered cuts on the face and arms. Both are in city hospital.
