

M'NUTT NAMES GREENLEE TO BE SECRETARY

Campaign Manager Given First Appointment of Administration.

Appointment of Pleas E. Greenlee of Shelbyville, former newspaper man and campaign manager for Paul V. McNutt as secretary to the Governor-elect, was announced today. This is the first appointment made by the new administration.

Greenlee was secretary of the McNutt-for-Governor clubs formed before the convention.

He was born in Rush county in 1861 and was reared in Shelby county.

Following graduation from high school he became a member of the staff of the Shelbyville Democrat. He enlisted in the 150th field artillery in 1917 and served as a private in France throughout the war.

Elected While Overseas

While overseas Greenlee was informed that he had been elected city clerk of Shelbyville, having been nominated in the primary that spring. He was sworn in by the American consul at St. Nazaire, France and was city clerk until the end of the war although his deputy performed the duties.

Upon his return to Shelbyville he was re-elected city clerk and in 1926 became advertising and business manager of the Shelbyville Democrat. He held this post until 1928 when he was appointed state adjutant of the American Legion.

Two years later he resigned, sold his interest in the Shelbyville paper and with Wray Fleming, purchased the Michigan City Dispatch.

Aided in Campaign

During this time he aided in managing McNutt's campaign and in August of this year Greenlee and Fleming sold the Michigan City paper, and the former became head of the veterans department of the Democratic state committee and the latter became publicity director.

Greenlee also served as engrossing clerk of the house of representatives during 1931.

He is married and has two children.

EDITOR ELEANOR OPENS WAR ON COMPETITION

Washington Papers Scrap Over Idea of Election Searchlight.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 11.—Editor Eleanor Patterson's sarcastic front-page editorials in the Washington Herald again are providing the capital with diversion from its usual run of political news.

Mrs. Patterson's target this time is not her personal and social rival, Mrs. Alice Roosevelt Longworth, but the Herald's morning competitor, the Washington Post.

The momentous issue between the two papers is this: Who shall have the credit for arranging a searchlight which signalled Governor Roosevelt's election on Tuesday night.

The post published a dignified half-page advertisement, asserting that it thought of the searchlight idea first. It claimed the Herald was trying to horn in on the glory.

Mrs. Patterson replied tartly in a signed editorial. She claimed priority rights on the signal arrangement, said that the Post seemed to think it "owns the sky."

\$60,000 FIRE SWEEPS THEATER IN BEDFORD

Building Is Destroyed by Flames; Boiler Room Blast Blamed.

BEDFORD, Ind., Nov. 11.—Fire swept the Von Ritz theater building here today, destroying it and several adjoining buildings and

causing damage estimated at between \$60,000 and \$75,000.
