

PUBLIC FUNDS ALLOTTED TO COUNTY BANKS

Twenty-Six Institutions Share in Deposits, Says Sexton.

Allotment of county, city and school city funds to various Marion county banks has been announced by County Treasurer Timothy P. Sexton.

The funds, to be deposited from 1933 and 1934 tax collections, were assigned by the county finance board.

Sexton stated the three governmental units now have approximately \$450,000 in defunct banks. The closed Washington Bank and Trust Company paid \$50,000 into the county treasury in 1932.

Twenty-six banks will share in the deposits. They include general funds, \$9,395,000; Barrett law, \$2,450,000; and special assessment, delinquent and deficit funds, \$50,000.

Funds Are Allotted

A total tax of \$18,022,224 is on books for collection in 1933. General funds were allowed as follows:

20 Per Cent of Land in County Reverts to State

Few Farmers Buy in Their Tracts at Virginia Tax Sale.

By Scripps-Howard Newspaper Alliance. SPOTSYLVANIA COURTHOUSE, Va., Jan. 13.—The commonwealth of Virginia today owns about 20 per cent of all the land in this county, after a depression delinquent tax sale.

Farmers came to the sale, listened to the auctioneer, but bid in only fourteen parcels out of 698 sold for unpaid taxes.

The other 685 were turned over to the state comptroller when there were no bidders.

Delinquent owners left their property to go for failure to pay taxes amounting to as little as 30 to 35 cents an acre. Small parcels were knocked down for as little as a few cents more than a dollar.

A small crowd of farmers lounged in the courthouse, talking and paying little attention to the auctioneer, M. B. Kinsey, as he hurried through the long list of delinquent owners and acreages.

The total sold was 133 acres. At the end of the sale Kinsey reminded the spectators that owners could get their titles back by paying delinquent taxes, plus penalties.

FILENE MAKES PLEA FOR FAIR CREDIT SYSTEM

Business Pays Best When It Pays Both Parties, Says Merchant.

"Human life begins with credit, from the time that the baby, which costs money, consumes for years before ever functioning as a producer," said Edward A. Filene, internationally known Boston merchant and philanthropist, at a meeting of the Indiana Credit Union League in the Antlers Thursday night.

"Credit always breaks down as an institution when one of the parties takes undue advantage of the other," Filene declared.

"The business of credit pays best when it pays both parties. That is a fundamental principle of finance which many financiers still have to learn."

Filene has been active in the establishing and financing of credit unions in this country since their inception some years ago.

He is president of the Credit Union National Extension Bureau and is making a series of talks in midwestern cities on the subject of credit unions. He opened his tour in Indianapolis Thursday noon with an address at the Columbia Club at a joint meeting of luncheon clubs.

During his stay in Indianapolis he conferred with Governor Paul V. McNutt, Walter C. Greenough, chairman of the state banking commission, and legislators interested in the introduction of a new banking bill.

Approximately three hundred were in attendance at the dinner. R. N. Phelps, president of the Indiana league, presided.

Many of the smaller tracts have been abandoned, according to county officials. Their unemployed owners have left the county seeking employment elsewhere.

DEMANDS QUICK AID FOR NEEDY

Wisconsin Governor Tells Legislature to Stress Relief Action.

By United Press. MADISON, Wis., Jan. 13.—Governor Albert G. Schmedeman, Wisconsin's new Democratic executive, called upon the state legislature Thursday to make the relief of immediate distress the principal business of this winter's session.

He urged that the legislature, long a breeding place of new and progressive philosophies of government, devote its entire energy toward abatement of distressed economic conditions and aid for depression-stricken citizens.

"It will be no time for the introduction of bills, resolutions and amendments which do not deal with our major problems," he said. "Overshadowing every problem is the economic situation with its

widespread disintegrating effects upon individual and family life." Only the general outlines of the Governor's program were submitted at this time. Specific financial recommendations will be made next month.

Wisconsin, he reported, will need \$25,800,000 for relief this year. Beyond the administration of direct relief, Schmedeman proposed more liberal laws on mortgage foreclosures and tax payments, more rigid banking and securities regulation, closer supervision of utilities and postponement of compulsory unemployment insurance for the time being.

The stress which Governors during the long rule of the La Follette progressive Republican dynasty in the statehouse had laid on education, highways and conservation was absent from the new executive's message.
