North Marion garage proprietor, Arnold Senefeld, who already faced federal liquor charges, and Mike Brown, Soldiers' home corner restaurant proprietor, all on liquor conspiracy charges, and Ora Kirby, Gas City restaurant proprietor, on perjury charges.

White also said he will not resign, pending trial, adding that he had done "all he could" to enforce the liquor and gaming laws.

All defendants arrested provided bond and were finger-printed by Matt Humble, Marion police identification expert. Two defendants not arrested were believed to be out of the city.

Edwards, now 31, was the youngest mayor in the state when elected in 1929. He has spent his entire life in Marion, operating a grocery from 1917 to 1924, and a general insurance agency from then until he assumed office. About ten years ago he engaged in amateur boxing as a bantamweight.

He has had a turbulent career as mayor, engaging in frequent tilts with his city officials. He sought the nomination for supreme and appellate courts reporter at the last state Democratic convention, but was unsuccessful.
