

BARE ATHLETIC FUND LOANS TO SCHOOL HEADS

Borrowing by Anderson Officials Disclosed in Accounts Report.

Borrowing of money by athletic fund officers, teachers, and J. L. Thalman, principal, was disclosed today in a report of field examiners of the state accounts board covering athletic fund and extra-curricular accounts at the Anderson high school.

Differences over the handling of the funds caused the Indiana High School Athletic Association to suspend the Anderson team from participating in the basketball tournament this year.

Examination of the funds then was asked and the report filed today with William Cosgrove, chief examiner.

It disclosed that Thalman owes the athletic fund \$300 and that H. P. Cook, former treasurer of the extra-curricular fund, owes the athletic fund \$417.

Examiners recommended that Cook, who resigned in June, 1932, be made to turn over \$1,915.77 of the fund to Winston Ashley, his successor in the treasurer's office.

Although on leave, Thalman's pay is being withheld until all accounts are settled, the report sets out. Other items, covering different dates, charge Cook with \$209 and Thalman with \$217, but the latter has been returned, the report says.

A \$75 item on a bank check stub also was found to have been issued to Thalman, but no record made of the transaction.

Practice of any lending was recommended discontinued.

Clarence M. Wertz and Carl B. Major were the examiners.

HIGH UTILITY RETURN UPHELD

Indiana Federal Court Judges Still Hold for 6 1/2 Per Cent Earnings.

Federal court judges in Indiana still are holding for a 6 1/2 per cent return in utility cases, it appeared yesterday.

This was disclosed in the new interlocutory decree received by Attorney-General Philip Lutz Jr., in the Logansport gas rate case. The court was handed down by a three-judge court at South Bend, whose original order was sent back for explanatory details by the United States supreme court.

Judges were Robert C. Baltzell, Thomas W. Slick and Will M. Sparks. The latter is from the federal court of appeals at Chicago, while the other two have Indiana district benches.

In their new decree they set out the rates set by the Indiana public service commission for gas service from the Indiana Public Service Corporation at Logansport, Peru and Wabash would not yield more than a 4 1/2 per cent return on fair value of property involved in the service.

It is "reasonably probable that the return would be less than 4 1/2 per cent," the decree sets out. It continues:

"The fair annual return which the plaintiff is entitled to earn on the fair and reasonable value of the property, used and useful, in furnishing and supplying gas to the public is probably not less than 6 1/2 per cent."

EDUCATION SYSTEM WILL BE REVAMPED

Duplication of Efforts to Be Eliminated in State Schools.
