

HITLER ORDERS DEMOCRACY TO BE ELIMINATED

All Traces of Majority Rule to Be Replaced by Individual Rule.

BERLIN, July 7.—Political parties finally have been eliminated in Germany and the next task must be elimination of all remaining traces of democracy. Chancellor Adolph Hitler told a conference of state governors Thursday.

It is especially important that majority rule be replaced by individual responsibility in the Nazi one-party state which has now been achieved, the chancellor said.

He declared the forces of revolution must be led into the channels of evolution, and economic conditions must be bettered.

In connection with the latter, he said he will not replace economic experts, who happen not to be Nazis, in favor of Nazis who do not understand economics.

INDEPENDENT OIL MEN SLAP PROPOSED CODE

Advertising Rule Is Menace, Says Secretary of Organization.

Fear that the proposed oil industry code would eliminate newspaper and radio advertising by independent and underselling companies was expressed today by Russell S. Williams, secretary of the new Independent and Individually Branded Petroleum Association of America.

The objectionable section is: "Broadcasting or publishing in any manner which lays claim to a policy generally underlying competitors is an unfair and uneconomic practice and is prohibited."

This rule will handicap independent, cash and carry and track-side oil stations which operate at low overhead, Williams said, and will be fought by a committee of which Sterling F. Mutz, Lincoln, Neb., is chairman.

NEW DELAY FACED IN ANDERSON MAYOR WAR

Harry Baldwin Files Petition for Change of Venue.

ANDERSON, Ind., July 7.—A petition for a change of venue from Madison circuit court today threatened to delay the second trial of quo warranto proceedings by which Jesse H. Mellett hopes to recover

the mayorship of Anderson from Harry R. Baldwin.

The petition was filed by Baldwin late Thursday.

John W. Craig, Greensburg, special judge in the case, is expected to rule on the motion immediately.

The second trial, ordered after the first ended in a jury disagreement, was scheduled to start July 11.

Earlier this week Judge Craig granted a motion of Mellett for a special venire of twenty-five persons from which to select the trial jury.

HOLD HOTELS MUST FILE ON WHEAT TAX

Makers of Own Bread Required to Pay, Say Revenue Officers.

The new federal processing tax on wheat, effective at midnight Saturday, requires hotels, restaurants, hospitals and other institutions preparing and serving their own bread and biscuits to make returns, internal revenue officials said today.

Any one who handles any commodity which is a product of wheat and is for sale must pay tax, it was explained.

Retail dealers will not be required to pay tax on separate retail stocks of flour, macaroni, breakfast foods, and similar commodities which are
