 LEGION ROARS PROTEST**

Headquarters Calm Down After
 Burning Cables With Messages.

National American Legion headquarters here was calmed down today as the result of apparent settlement of an international dispute over conferring "honorary" memberships on King Victor Emanuel and Uremir Benito Mussolini of Italy.

Press dispatches carried the news of the honor conferred on the two by Colonel W. E. Easterwood, Dallas, Tex., national vice-commander.

Then the cable wires hummed with protests from Legion chiefs, who, in no uncertain terms, informed Easterwood that the Legion constitution makes no provision for honorary memberships.

Apparently, the matter is settled, but officials here are wondering just how seriously Easterwood meant his threat to take the matter before the next national convention.


The Indianapolis fire department band will give a concert tonight at the open air theater in Garfield Park. More than 4,000 persons have been attending these Friday night programs.
