

## WAGE BOOSTS ORDERED FOR STATE PLANTS

Hundreds of Workers to  
Share in Increased Pay  
Schedules.

**AUSTIN, Ind., July 18.**—Increases over the original contract price for products grown for the Austin, Scottsburg, Brownstown, Columbus and Edinburg factories of the Morgan Packing Company, were announced today.

Growers will receive \$20,000 more than contract prices, Ivan C. Morgan, president of the packing company, estimated.

The increases are for July and August deliveries and raise prices to the 1932 levels.

## Evansville Man May Become Exile for Kindness to Bird With Broken Leg

**EVANSVILLE, Ind., July 18.**—Charged with illegally possessing a red bird which he nursed back to health, Foster Lewis, Evansville business man, today threatened to leave the United States if he is convicted in connection with the case.

Lewis found the bird with a broken leg in his yard. To protect it from cats and other dangers he took it in the house, and tended it until the leg had healed.

Since then the bird has refused to leave his home.

Edwin W. Aleon, deputy game warden, swore out a warrant against Lewis charging him with "illegally possessing a red bird in violation of the migratory bird treaty act."

Lewis, head of the Tri-State Schools Supply Company, pleaded guilty before Federal Court Commissioner Robert C. Enlow, and was bound over to the federal grand jury.

"If I am sent to jail, I shall leave the United States immediately after my release," Lewis said after complaining that the charges were unjust.

## LABOR MEETING DATE CHANGED

Mass Session at Tomlinson  
Hall to Be Held on  
Night of July 31.

Date for the mass meeting to unionize all unorganized labor in Indianapolis has been changed from Wednesday night to the night of July 31, it was announced today by the committee in charge.

It will be held, as previously scheduled, at Tomlinson hall. Adolph Fritz, Indiana State Federation of Labor secretary, reported that an intensive state drive to organize under the national recovery act is meeting with success.

One hundred and twenty-five workers at the Chapman-Price plant here formed a union Saturday, he said.

In Bloomington, the Central Labor Council has carried out a campaign resulting in affiliation of 700 furniture workers, 300 painters in Bloomington and Bedford, and 125 quarry workers. The latter is expected to expand to include 700, Fritz declared.

## DRIVE ON DELINQUENT TAXPAYERS LAUNCHED

Force of Twenty Deputies to Serve  
Formal Demand on Residents.

Collection of delinquent taxes owed by approximately 38,000 Marion county residents will be started to-

day by a force of twenty special deputies from the office of County Treasurer Timothy P. Sexton.

Formal demand will be made on each person owing personal, property or poll tax, according to Lawrence Sexton, who is in charge of delinquent collections.

Shortage in the May installment collections has been a severe blow

to city, county and school budgets, Sexton pointed out, and the delinquent collections will be pressed in an effort to deplete the shrunken funds.

Penalty of 3 per cent, plus a flat demand charge of 25 cents, is assessed against delinquent taxes. Interest at an annual rate of 8 per cent from May 1 also is charged.
