

POLICEMAN IS VINDICATED IN 'BEATING' CASE

Accuser of Sergeant Kruse Is Sentenced to 30 Days on Farm.

Sergeant Ed Kruse, accused of beating up James Jordan, in arresting him, was vindicated today in criminal court on an appeal by Jordan.

Criminal Judge Frank P. Baker fined Jordan \$1 and costs and sentenced him to thirty days at the penal farm for resisting an officer. The municipal court sentence on this charge was \$50 and costs and six months. Baker also assessed a \$3 and costs fine on a profanity charge, the same as in the lower court.

alleged to have used loud and abusive language late at night in the office of Dr. Tell C. Waltermire, 1339 North Pennsylvania street.

Residents of the neighborhood upheld Kruse, asserting Jordan was drunk and attacked the officer.

CITY COUNCIL PUTS TAX ON POULTRY SALES

Ordinance Includes License Fees Ranging Up to \$200.

Ordinance for regulation of the sale of poultry was passed by city council Monday night and includes license fees ranging from \$1 to \$200 a year.

Farmers selling poultry and eggs from their own land will be required to pay \$1 for a card. Retailers will pay a license fee of \$25 a year. All others selling poultry and eggs will be classed as itinerant peddlers and required to pay an annual license fee of \$200.

Other ordinances adopted include: Permission for sale of a \$161,000

bond issue to obtain funds to pay past due water and light bills.

Permission for purchase of an ambulance for the city hospital.

Ordinances introduced include one to make Fairfield avenue from Central avenue to Woodland drive a preferential thoroughfare, and the same classification for the entire length of Michigan street.

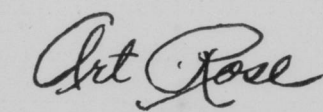

CLAIM CONFESSIONS IN BANDIT CASES

Two Alleged Members of Gang 'Crack,' Police Say.

Confessions from two of an alleged bandit gang declared by police to have committed fourteen robberies

in Indianapolis recently, including the stickup on the Hugh McK. Landon estate, July 7, have been obtained, according to the police.

Paul Parker, 21, of 1223 East Sixth street and Richard Turner, 21, of 2039 Ludlow avenue, both in Marion county jail charged with robbery, are alleged by the police to have admitted their parts in the holdups.

Noble Claycombe, 30, of 1233 North State avenue and William Shaw, 19, of 1225 North State avenue, two

other alleged members of the gang, are being held in Muncie. James Turner, 51, father of Richard, is held on a charge of conspiring in the robberies, though not actually participating in any.
