ADDING VITAMINS MAY ENDANGER FOOD

British Medical Officer Attacks Practice Severely.

LONDON, Oct. 6.—The large-scale consumption of foods to which extra vitamins have been added may endanger public health if it is carried much farther.

This risk of widespread hyper-vitaminosis is suggested by Sir George Newman, chief medical officer of the British ministry of health, in his annual report just issued here.

"There is a tendency at the present time," states Sir George, "for manufacturers to avail themselves of the publicity value of recent vitamin research by adding vitamins empirically to a variety of foods without due consideration of the results which may accrue from such haphazard practices."

"If a halt is not called to this indiscriminate dosing of foods with vitamins there is a possibility of a disturbance in the balance of nutrition which may have wide-reaching effects, and which it is not unreasonable to contemplate with some uneasiness."

More Study Given Bucs

A tabulation of the male population of New York state on this new classification shows that approximately 21 per cent of the gainfully employed males in New York fall in class 1, and 29 per cent in class 3, leaving 50 per cent in the intermediate class 2.

In commenting on this new classification to a representative of Science Service, Professor Pearl said:

"While we hear a good deal of rather vague talk and writing about social organization, there is need for more precise statistical description and analysis of the actually existing organization of society. Human society has actually evolved a great many more of what amount to differentiated castes than have ant or termite societies. But we know practically nothing about what proportion of our human worker castes are either optional or necessary."

THREE GROUPS OF POPULATION SET FOR STUDY

Biologist Fixes Basis for Social and Economic Analysis Work.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 6.—Human society has evolved many more different castes than have ant and termite societies. To Americans steeped in the idea that "all men are created free and equal," this may seem to be a statement more applicable to India or some land other than the U. S. A.

Nevertheless, such is the finding of Professor Raymond Pearl of the Johns Hopkins University, a leading biologist, who has prepared a new classification and code of occupations for use in analysis of social and economic conditions.

In research in human biology, Professor Pearl and his associates study such important factors as the death rate, the birth rate, and differential fertility. The new occupational classification which he discusses in the current number of the scientific journal, Human Biology, will permit a more thorough and penetrating analysis of the effect of social and economic forces as they influence population. It is the first step in a systematic plan of research on population "castes" that is being undertaken in the department of biology of the Johns Hopkins School of Hygiene and Public Health at Baltimore.

Three Broad Groupings

This new classification puts all occupations into three broad classes as follows: 1. Owners, managers, officials and professional men; 2. Skilled and semi-professional workers; 3. Laborers—unskilled and semi-skilled.

The primary purpose is to contrast, for research purposes, two classes of persons, namely those in class 1 and those in class 2. Class 1 persons are, on the whole, situated at or near the top of things in the existing social organization. Those in class 3 are at or near the bottom in the same social organization. This leaves the second class who are neither very near the top nor the bottom, who if they sometimes think themselves worse off than those in class 1 are plainly and admittedly better off than those in class 3.

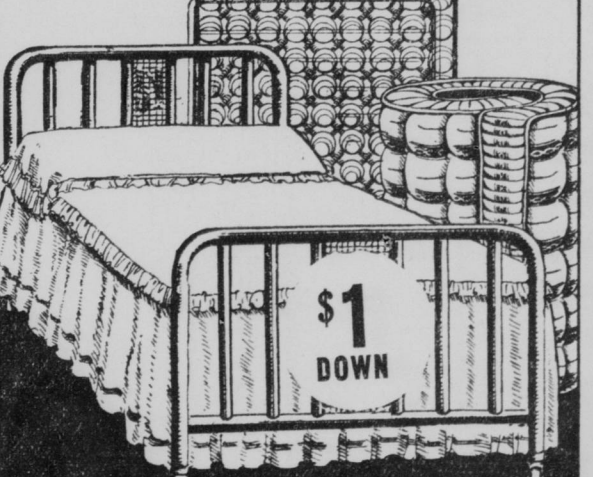
