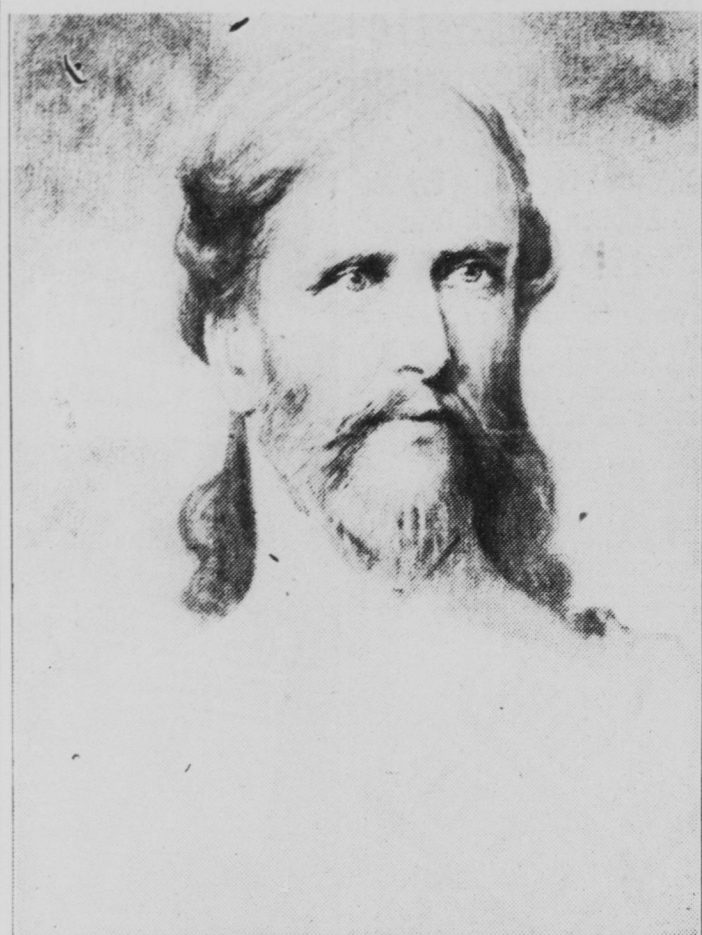

All ceremonies will be held in virgin timber sites on Mackinac island, which have changed little in

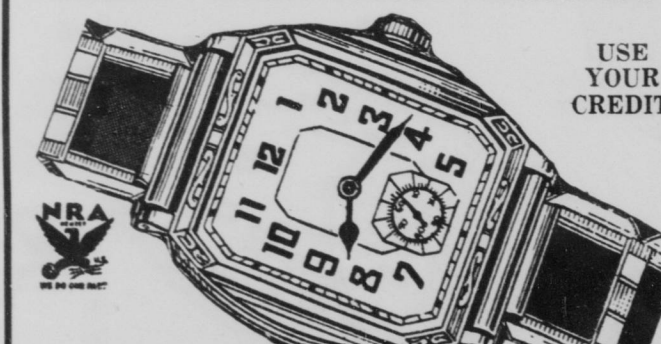
## SENTENCE FATHER OF 8

## JURORS DEADLOCKED IN SCOTTSBORO CASE

Sentence to Be Passed on Negro Convicted Third Time.

DECATUR, Ala., Dec. 6.—A deadlocked jury continued deliberations today on the fate of Clarence Norris, second Negro accused in the Scottsboro case to be retried.

Judge Callahan was to pass formal sentence of death today on Heywood Patterson, convicted for the third time here last week.

Cases of the five other defendants still awaiting second trial were postponed indefinitely yesterday by Judge Callahan. Defense counsel asked the continuance pending appeal of Patterson's third conviction through the state supreme court, and if necessary, the United States supreme court.
