

# TAX SALE STAY WILL BE MADE FINAL, IS HINT

Court Scans Minnesota  
Ruling to Support  
Such Decision.

An order permanently restraining Marion county officials from conducting the 1934 delinquent tax sale, scheduled to begin Feb. 12, probably will be issued today by Judge William A. Pickens of superior court, Room 3.

Plaintiffs in a suit to enjoin county officials from proceeding with this sale obtained last Monday a temporary order prohibiting officials from making preparations for the sale.

The action was brought by Ezra Bunnell, Beach Grove real estate broker, on behalf of all delinquent taxpayers of the county, numbering about 10,000 and owing several million dollars.

First arguments on the permanent restraining order were heard yesterday. Judge Pickens announced that he would enjoin the sale if he found that a United States supreme court decision in the recent Minnesota case gave him power to do so.

The judge also declared that, in his opinion, the sale can not be conducted legally because it is scheduled to begin on a legal holiday.

## 118 ADDITIONAL NURSES RECEIVE EMPLOYMENT

Results Obtained by Service Distribution Committee.

Efforts of the special committee on nursing service distribution of the Indiana State Nurses Association have resulted in the employment of 118 additional graduate nurses in hospitals having nurses' training schools, it was announced today. Thirty-five graduates were given part time work. These results were accomplished in a year's time.

This was possible, the committee reports, because of contacts with hospitals and organizations that are potential employers of nurses, adoption of minimum standards for official registries in Indiana and the establishment of the nursing service bureau in Indianapolis.

# PENALTIES CUT, UTILITY USERS REAP HARVEST

\$300,000 Monthly Saving  
Is Foreseen as Ruling  
Takes Effect.

Monthly savings of delinquent penalties amounting to an estimated \$300,000 to utility rate payers throughout the state, became effective today through an order of the public service commission.

Last December, the commission ruled that on Feb. 1, 1934, delinquent penalties of 10 per cent could be levied for bills to \$3 and 3 per cent over \$3 fifteen days after date due.

Practice of most utilities has been to charge the 10 per cent on all amounts. Attempt of the former Insull companies to delay the date of effectiveness of the order failed.

Only local utility making delinquent charges was the Indianapolis Power and Light Company. They also fought the change. It will mean a savings of thousands of dollars to consumers of that company, it was estimated.
