

# HOUSE LEADERS REGAIN CONTROL

Anti-Administration Moves Muffled as President Returns.

WASHINGTON, April 13.—President Roosevelt's house leaders suddenly recovered their wavering control today and apparently succeeded in muzzling a series of anti-administration drives that had sprouted in the President's absence.

The leaders side-tracked the McLeod bank deposit "pay off" bill, the Frazier-Lemke \$2,500,000,000 inflation-farm mortgage bill, and the Feinsinger silver monetization bill.

Similar pressure awaits the thirty-hour work week bill if the President desires it.

The question of thirty-hour work week legislation will be put up to the President later this week by majority leaders. Representative William P. Connery (Dem., Mass.), author of the house bill, said he and President William Green of the American Federation of Labor will confer with the President next week.

# CLAIM DOCTORS FAKED PERMIT

Grand Jurors Charge Pair Falsified Certificate of Accident Victim.

CHICAGO, April 13.—Two physicians and an undertaker were recommended today for investigation in connection with the filing of a false death certificate for Franklin H. Wolever, 61, candy company engineer.

The recommendation from a Cook county grand jury asked a thorough inquiry into the activities of Dr. G. N. Green, insurance company physician; Dr. Abel P. M. Sandahl, Wolever family physician, and William E. Schmidt, undertaker.

The jury found that Mr. Wolever was crushed to death March 20 by a truck operating under charter for the candy company. A death certificate attributed his death to heart disease.

The grand jury's report came after a son, Robert Wolever, investigated his father's death. An exhumation was ordered and medical evidence showed the man died as the result of the injuries received from the truck accident, the jury found.

# GROUP TO AID NAZI VICTIMS TO BE FORMED

Organization to Be Made by Eugene Bechtold.

A local committee to aid victims of Nazi measures will be organized here tonight by Eugene Bechtold, lecturer, at a meeting of the John Reed Club forum at 8 in the Lincoln Traveltime room. Mr. Bechtold will speak on "World Forces Against Fascism."

In other addresses throughout the country Mr. Bechtold has predicted the development of Fascism out of the Paris-Stavinsky scandal. England's ultimate reaction to the militarism of international politics with which the speaker will deal.

The speaker also will discuss certain overt steps that already have been taken toward Fascism in the United States. Mr. Bechtold believes that the political trend of all western countries definitely is toward Fascism.
