

NEW YORK, April 30.—Twenty million American motorists, the thousands of shareholders in the automotive and allied industries, wearers of rubber foot-wear and users of mechanical goods have an interest in the rubber restriction negotiations now being concluded in Amsterdam.

Great Britain and Holland for several months have been discussing the world rubber situation. These countries own about 90 per cent of the world's rubber trees. They are going to tell the world what they are going to do to get rid of 700,000 tons of surplus rubber—almost as much as the world used in 1932—and curtail future production.

The United States consumes more than half of the world's rubber production, so naturally our tire, foot-wear, mechanical goods, and other manufacturers utilizing rubber are concerned about attempts to wipe out the surplus and reduce supplies.
