# STREET CAR CO. WORKERS SHARE \$31,000 BONUS

Earnings With New Equipment Show Substantial Gain Over Old Lines.

Employees of Indianapolis Railways, Inc., have received more than \$31,000 through the result of the profit-sharing agreement reached last year by the company and its employees, it was stated today in the company's annual financial report.

This sum is equal to approximately 3 1/2 cents an hour additional earnings for car and bus operators, with proportionate amounts for other grade employees.

Earnings of the new street cars and trackless trolleys during the year were 14.5 and 3 per cent, respectively, over the old type lines, the company announced.

In the first two years of operation the reorganized street car company will have accomplished 60 per cent of the original ten-year improvement plan, the report says.

Report shows a 36 per cent increase in gross income before depreciation charges for the year 1933 over 1932, despite a loss in gross revenue of \$240,295.
